THE DANGEROUS DRUGS ACT

**THE DANGEROUS DRUGS (DESIGNATION OF LAND FOR CULTIVATION OF
GANJA FOR SACRAMENTAL PURPOSES) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 2023**

In exercise of the power conferred on the Minister by section 7D(6) of the Dangerous Drugs Act, and every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs (Designation of Land for Cultivation of Ganja for Sacramental Purposes) (Amendment) Order, 2023.

2.—(1) In relation to a person listed in Column 1 of Part I of the Schedule, the Minister upon being satisfied that the person—

- (a) has attained the age of eighteen years; and
- (b) is an adherent of the Rastafarian faith or any group of such persons,

hereby authorizes that person to cultivate, on lands designated in Column 2 of Part I of the Schedule in respect of that person, ganja for use for religious purposes as a sacrament in adherence to the Rastafarian faith.

(2) In relation to an organization listed in Column 1 of Part II of the Schedule, the Minister upon being satisfied that the organization is comprised of persons who—

- (a) have attained the age of eighteen years; and
- (b) are adherents to the Rastafarian faith or any group of such persons,

hereby authorizes that organization to cultivate on lands designated in Column 2 of Part II of the Schedule in respect of that organization, ganja for use for religious purposes as a sacrament in adherence to the Rastafarian faith.

3. Each person, and organization, listed in the Schedule, shall—

- (a) promptly comply with any directives issued by the Minister responsible for Justice pursuant to this Order or to power vested in the Minister by any other applicable law;
- (b) ensure that its servants, agents, employees, independent contractors and third-party partners adhere to the terms and conditions of this Order or any other terms and conditions that may be prescribed by the Minister from time to time;
- (c) ensure that it employs adequate security measures in order to safeguard the ganja, including the lands on which the ganja is being cultivated and the facilities being used for the authorized activity;
- (d) at all reasonable times allow any body authorized for the purposes of this sub-paragraph by the Minister to inspect its facilities wherein cultivation and research into the ganja plants are being conducted so as to ensure that the provisions of this Order, the Act and other regulations made thereunder are being upheld;
- (e) maintain accounts and records in such manner as may be notified in writing by the Minister, to the person or organization (as the case may be) for the purposes of this sub-paragraph;
- (f) from time to time, provide such information, reports and records as may be reasonably requested by any body designated by the Minister by notice published in the *Gazette* for the purposes of this sub-paragraph.

4. The Minister shall provide a letter of authorization to each person and organization, listed in the Schedule, providing a detailed description of the designated lands on which the cultivation of ganja can take place for the purposes of this Order.
