## **SKNCIC Nevis Division Mix & Mingle Unites Business Leaders in an Evening of Connection, Growth, and Community**

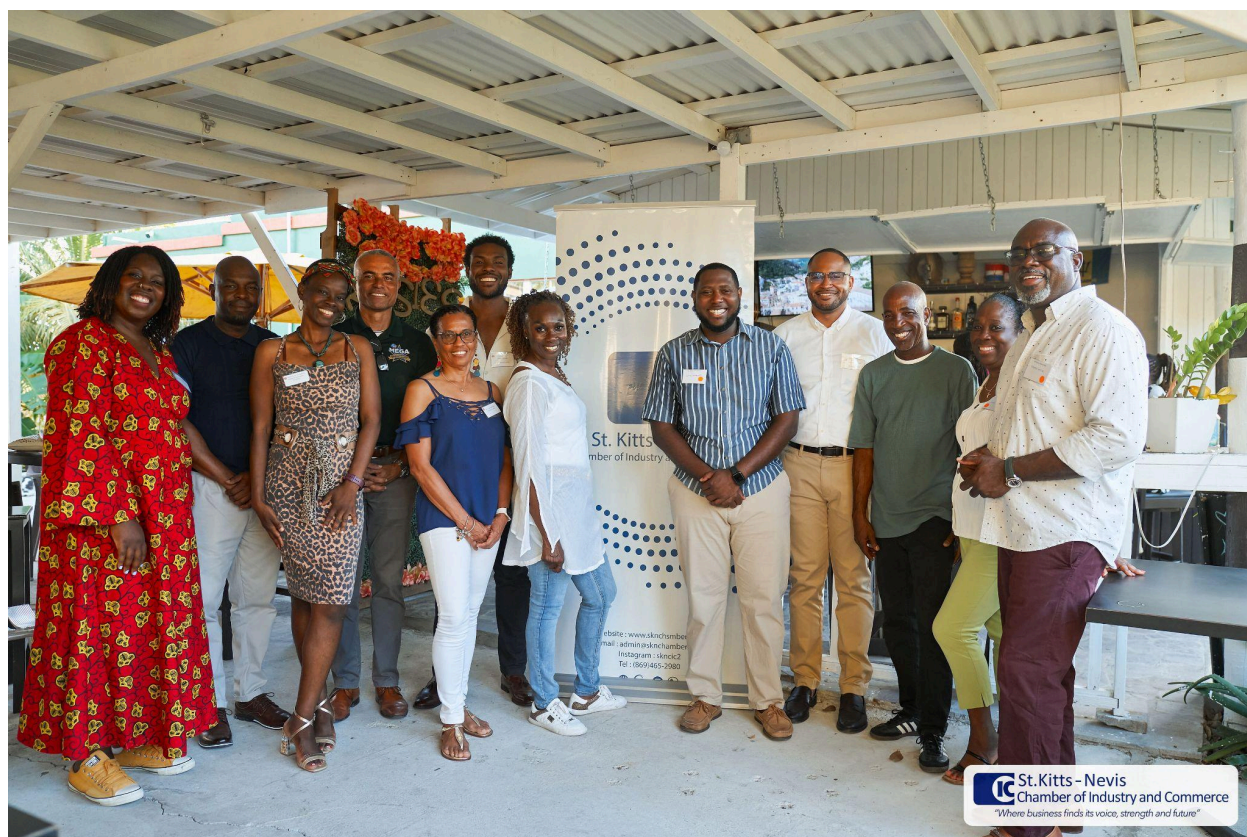
New members, Chamber leadership, and generous sponsors mark a milestone evening as the Division celebrates its 30th anniversary year
