2.) Keep Your Topics Trending

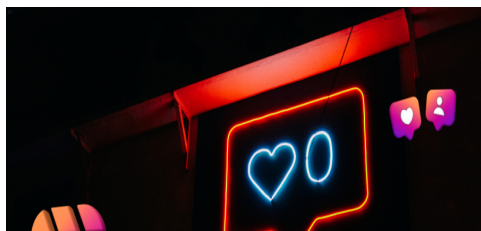
