Tir Na N'og (pronounced "Tier nah Nohg") is Gaelic for "Land of the Youth". Irish legends and myths tell of a land where mortal time was suspended and everyone was young and beautiful. A place where we all no doubt aspire to live in. These are words and dreams of John Larchet, the legendary Irish/Aussie wine adventurer and visionary. In his honor, three friends will continue the dream with this wine sourced from an old vine Grenache vineyard planted in 1910. The youthful character and wonderful intensity of flavor are courtesy of low yielding old Grenache vines. Despite their age, they fit well in Tir Na N'og and the legend lives on. Barry, John & Nick

Old Vines Grenache Technical Notes

Grapes - Old vine Grenache from our 2 acre vineyard planted in 1910 with a very small amount of old vine Shiraz from the same vineyard.

TNN is carefully crafted using traditional open fermenters, maturation in seasoned French & American oak for 12 months and blended with a small amount of Shiraz from the same vineyard. The finished wine is then bottled under DIAM cork to preserve the immortality of a beautiful wine.

The 2021 Tir na N'og Old Vine Grenache is dark, spicy and brooding on the nose, with layers of Christmas spice, black and red berries and the earthy base of licorice and iodine. In the mouth, the wine silky, dark and statuesque. The tannins are very finely countersunk into the fruit; they are chalky and gently grippy and shape the fruit in the mouth. With very good length of flavor through the finish, this is built to last some time. Very smart.
