

Brexit Deal Proposal

Unfortunately, watching the Brexit situation progress has been like watching a car crash or train wreck unfold in slow motion.

I am sure that many of you feel that it is a colossal mess and are rightfully extremely angry, both at the contempt shown to the electorate and at the political dishonesty that has been shown by both sides.

We have a proposal that could with your support perhaps change matters.

A no-deal would be an extremely unfortunate move to make as all of the agreement would be ditched and all current cooperative agreements with our biggest trading partners would evaporate.

To achieve the following we propose acceptance of the negotiated agreement with the backstop removed and a two year continuation of the currently negotiated extension be applied while agreement is achieved.

We would propose that the backstop be dropped from the agreement and instead a negotiation for a thirty year reconciliation and reunification of Northern Ireland with the Republic of Ireland outside of the European Union but within a federal union of nations comprising the United Kingdom and the Republic of Ireland. (A petition of 250,000 signed over a two month period would be sufficient to prevent a referendum or legislation to leave the Federated Union of Nations for Ireland this would be to protect citizens who wished to remain part of the Federal Union of Nations. This would not be a sticking plaster like the Good Friday agreement but a process of reconciliation and healing. There would have to be federal laws for trade, political rights and standards and human rights including abortion rights through all member nations.

By creating a federal council of autonomous nations (England, Ireland, Scotland and Wales) we create self-governing nations with equality at a national level with one man and one woman representing each participating nation at a federal level we also create equality of nations.

There is the hope that what we are trying to do for Northern Ireland and the Republic we can do for Palestine and Israel also as member states within the federation.

We would suggest creating a trading regulation and quality control framework for nations within and without the European Union with representatives from all participating nations and I would propose removing access fees to sell within the single market as some tariffs would always be imposed such as a carbon tariff and an automation tariff, this would create a situation that empowers the transit of goods internationally.

We would suggest creating a shared tariff regulation framework (see Post Brexit Tariffs) based upon principles and not the protection of industries and again I would promote this as an international agreement not just for the UK and EU as more and more nations signed up it would become more powerful.
