



Players First Recreational Soccer – Code of Conduct

By participating in the Players First Recreational Soccer program, the players, coaches, families and spectators agree to abide by the following:

- Demonstrate appropriate behavior during all games and practices and follow the rules, regulations, and procedures set forth in emails and communication provided by Players First Staff and volunteer coaches via PlayMetrics.
- Follow the code of conduct as set forth by Players First Recreational Soccer and [US Youth Soccer](#).
- Compete in the spirit of good sportsmanship.
- Respect teammates, coaches, referees, opponents, spectators, and staff.

The Players First Recreational Soccer program has a zero-tolerance policy concerning poor sportsmanship and inappropriate behavior, including but not limited to profanity, threats, or any negative or insulting remarks directed at a referee, staff member, coach, player or spectator.

Parents are expected to share these expectations with their child and are responsible for their child's behavior and compliance. Parents are also responsible for sharing these expectations with any invited spectators.

Failure of players, coaches, family, or spectators to comply with the above expectations may result in the following consequences: a temporary removal or permanent suspension from the practice, game, or program.
