



Sally Jane is a nationally touring country artist whose career continues to climb, built on a blend of authenticity, hard work, and unforgettable performances.

Hailing from the small Western Australian town of Serpentine, Sally's journey has taken her across every state and territory in Australia—crossing the Nullarbor fifteen times and playing iconic stages including the Tamworth Country Music Festival, where she opened the 2020 event and performed for the legendary Joy McKean's 90th birthday. Since 2018 Sally Jane has regularly released music with her latest single “Fishing Taught Me Patience” reaching high in the charts.

2026 has seen Sally Jane be finalist in the West Australian Song of the Year awards- Country Category, WA Country Music Awards (People's Choice award Winner, Video Clip of the Year Finalist, Emerging Artist Finalist, Contemporary Song Finalist and Traditional Song Finalist), ICMI (Video Clip of the Year & Best New Talent finalist) and a finalist in the Listen Up Music songwriting competition.

In 2024, Sally released two standout singles: “*Ain't Afraid of Dirt*”, an empowering anthem that reflects her down-to-earth lifestyle, and “*Bombs & Bullets*” (featuring Luke O'Shea), a heartfelt tribute to Australian veterans and their families—a community close to her heart. “*Bombs & Bullets*” reached #1 on the AMRAP Regional Radio Charts marking it as her third #1 song in these charts. These two songs have earned Sally nominations at this year's West Australian Country Music Awards in five categories including a chance in the People's Choice category, having previously won the award in 2020.

Since 2017, Sally Jane's extensive touring has taken her music to every state and territory in Australia, performing in pubs, festivals and community events for crowds all ages, further cementing her reputation as one of Australia's hardest-working country artists.

Her debut EP earned critical recognition, with three of its four tracks breaking into the Top 10 of the AMRAP Regional Charts—including the #1 single “*Kiss You When The Rain Comes.*” She has also been celebrated in the West Australian Music Song of the Year Awards (finalist for “*Too Young*”) and on the global stage, with “*No Time*” reaching the Semi-Finals in Nashville's international Unsigned Only songwriting competition.

Beyond performing, Sally Jane is expanding her creative reach as a contributing editor for *Guitar Thrills Magazine* (Florida, USA), where she interviews influential artists including Pseudo Echo. Her dedication has also attracted major brand partnerships, with ambassadorships for Takamine Guitars (via Pro Music Australia), Thomas Cook Clothing Co., Wrangler Western Wear Australia, Audio-Technica Australia, and her first financial sponsorship with Spinifex Brewing Co.

From small-town beginnings to national stages, Sally Jane continues to prove she's a rising force in country music—grounded, genuine, and just getting started.
