It is the perfect base to start the tour, as it is central to the southern golf courses of Scotland including St Andrews. Apart from its extensive list of restaurants and cafes, Dundee also boasts the Discovery / Scott Museum. Once we are settled it is time to head out for our first taste of Scotland... both visually and a dram in a glass.

Tuesday 8 September



This morning, we take a look at what put Dundee on the map... The home of the famous DISCOVERY. Just minutes from our hotel, we spend an hour exploring this incredible ship that did so much to open the Antarctic to the world.



And then... it's time to play golf in Scotland. Today we play PANMURE GC, the 21st oldest golf club in the world and designed by the legendary duo of Old Tom Morris and James Braid. The course combines the best elements of links and heathland, with tight fairways, challenging carries and undulating greens and is widely acknowledged as a more enjoyable round of golf than the nearby punishing Carnoustie with certainly more authentic Scottish golfing experience. PANMURE is a regular on the OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP qualifying course schedule.

Tuesday 8 September

Our next round of golf is on the magnificent Jubilee course at St Andrews. Lying between the OLD COURSE and the sea, many rate it as the better of the two courses.



The OLD COURSE is always a dream of golfers.... And other than the expensive way of getting to play, there are other ways of making it happen. All group golfers will be automatically placed in the daily ballot system and we shall also use the other options available. Our success rate is 99,2% for those wanting to play.



Thursday 10 September



Today we are back at St Andrews to play ST ANDREWS NEW COURSE... rated by many Scottish and global golfers as the best golf course at St Andrews. And for the golfers keen to play the Old Course at St Andrews, we shall again use all the ballot options, as well as our connections with the Starter to get our golfers onto the Old Course. Alternatively, the mid-afternoon "weather slots" are the other "on the day" means of playing the Old Course.



Friday 11 September



Today has been kept open for everyone to spend the day they want to ... time with the non-golfers, back to St Andrews, or a round of golf close by. A great links course is SCOTSCRAIG, where many clients have enjoyed a social round over the years. Founded in 1817, Scotsraig is another example of a true Scottish golf course.





After breakfast we head to Edinburgh where we book into our central hotel during a very busy day. After dropping our luggage at our central hotel, we spend the day exploring Edinburgh, a city filled with history, culture, fascinating shopping and wall to wall photo opportunities.





This evening we enjoy one of the most talked-about highlights of Edinburgh. The **Johnnie Walker Experience**. Not just here for whisky drinkers, the Johnnie Walker Experience has five-star tours, immersive tastings, rooftop bars, astonishing views of Edinburgh Castle, expertly crafted cocktails, locally sourced cuisine and an outstanding store with rare whiskies and amazing merchandise. An experience to remember. We start the visit with a tasting and introduction to Scottish whiskies, before heading to the rooftop bar for the best view of the city below.





A very full day... this morning we visit GLENKINCHIE DISTILLERY for a tour and tasting, with the opportunity to purchase rare and fine whiskies in their impressive shop.
