



CCW Recommended Course Progression

Course 1: NRA Basic Pistol Course

MNS provides NRA sponsored Basic Pistol Course training. MNS is a certified NRA instructor with real world military and law enforcement experience. NRA based courses are the gold standard and accepted widely across the Nation. The NRA trains over 1 million people throughout the country every year. The NRA Basic Pistol Course will train you on firearm safety, firearm operation, ammunition, shooting skills and more. This course is the foundation to meet your concealed carry needs.

This course will likely meet your state CCW permit requirements for 8 hours of in-person training from an accredited firearms training organization. MNS can assist with verifying your state training requirements. This course meets the Virginia State firearms training requirements for CCW permits.

Course 2: NRA CCW Course

The NRA Concealed Carry Pistol Course is designed for personal defense. The NRA CCW course takes place in a traditional classroom and range environment.

This course will provide knowledge and skills in, Firearm Safety, Pistol Nomenclature, Selecting a Pistol for Self Defense, Basic Defensive Pistol Skills, Drawing from Concealment, Stoppage Remediation, Mindset, Carry Modes, Firearm Cleaning, Training Activities and more.

This course is a natural progression from the NRA basic pistol course. In some cases, students can start with this course but MNS recommends all shooters take the NRA Basic Pistol Course first. If you are interested in taking only the CCW course please contact us to discuss your current pistol skills and abilities.

Course 3: Private Lessons

Following the NRA Basic Pistol and CCW Courses we recommend private lessons for advance self defense tactics such as cover and concealment, movement, vehicle born tactics, low light, multiple weapon deployment, room clearing tactics, communications and more. This training is considered specialized and will be tailored to meet the needs of each student.

Please do NOT bring loaded firearms to training. All firearms must be unloaded, secured in a closed container with ammunition in a separate container prior to arriving. Staff will verify all firearms are unloaded prior to starting the class. A safety brief will be provided at the start of the class and is available at www.MNShooting.com



All shooters will be required to sign and date a release, waiver, indemnification, hold harmless and assumption of risk agreement prior to the course. MNSHOOTING, LLC will provide the form and collect at the beginning of the course.
