



Getting Started

Step 1: What to Expect

MNS instructs in an objective based approach for effective learning. Instructor will demonstrate and provide explanations and monitor the progress of each student. Each student will meet the learning objectives before moving on to the next skill.

The ideal student to instructor ratio for organized courses is one-to-one. Larger course will typically involve more instructors present to support the personalized development of each student.

MNS uses a variety of ranges in the Northern Virginia area. The primary indoor range is Elite Shooting Sports, Virginia. Private lessons can be conducted at a private outdoor range in Fredericksburg, VA.

Step 2: Find a Course

What is your WHY?

MNS would like to understand why you are taking firearms training so we can customize training to fit your needs. When you contact us with interests to take training, MNS will reach out to learn about your current capabilities, your intent, and goals. With this information, customized training plans will be provided our particular courses of introduction can be recommended.

Step 3: Identify Course Availability

MNS competes in practical pistol shooting competitions world-wide with extensive travel. Availability is typically built around this competition schedule. We recommend booking a course or private lesson 14 days in advance to secure a desired time. However, we are willing to work with customers so always feel free to reach out and request a specific time that may not be listed.

MNS regularly inputs competition schedules in both the BLOG page and Events page for situational awareness. 2021 as been updated.

Step 4: Register

There are a few options to register for a course. NRA basic pistol courses can be booked under "TRAIN" section. Please ensure there is a marked NRA course date listed in Events first which should correspond to your booking. All other available dates are offered for private lessons.

Step 5: Payment

MNS accepts electronic payment and cash. When you register for a course or private lesson, an invoice will be sent to you with options to pay online. Paying online is preferred. We support VISA and MasterCard, Paypal, and ApplePay. Gift cards can also be purchased on our website and used at time the invoice is received. If payment is not received before class you reservation may be offered to someone on the waiting list.

Student Cancellations

Should you need to reschedule a booking we ask that it be canceled or a new date be booked within 7 days before the start of a course and 2 days before private lessons. All bookings done within this manner will receive full refund. Partial refunds will be offered when requesting a refund outside the aforementioned timelines. We understand that special circumstances outside our control occur, during these cases, please contact us at mnshooting@yahoo.com to discuss options.

MNS reserves the right to cancel all courses. Refunds will be made available when MNS initiates the canceling.

Legal Requirements

All students must be in good standing and be able to possess a firearm legally. Background checks may need to be performed in order to receive instruction. MNS seeks to only train shooters with good character and that are responsible law abiding citizens.

MNS reserves the right to terminate any instruction for safety and good standing reasons without refund.

A release of liability waiver MUST be signed for all training. Failure to sign waivers will terminate all training without refund.

Minors must be accompanied by an adult, preferably a parent or guardian.

Students may not be under the influence of any drugs, alcohol or substance that may impair their ability to operate a firearm and hear instructions from a range officer.

MATERIALS:

- Firearm (Can be provided)
- Ammunition (recommend 100 rounds)
- Hearing & Eye Protection (optional)
- Course Completion Certificate (Provided at end of course)

NO LIVE AMMUNITION IN THE CLASSROOM!

Please do NOT bring loaded firearms to training. All firearms must be unloaded, secured in a closed container with ammunition in a separate container prior to arriving. Staff will verify all firearms are unloaded prior to starting the class. A safety brief will be provided at the start of the class and is available at www.MNShooting.com



All shooters will be required to sign and date a release, waiver, indemnification, hold harmless and assumption of risk agreement prior to the course. MNSHOOTING, LLC will provide the form and collect at the beginning of the course.
