

Welcome to Providence Christian Academy Homeschool Co-Op. Thursday's are elective days and open to students in PK-12th grades. Please feel free to register your child for classes they are interested in and the ones they are eligible for by grade. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to let me know.

All classes need a minimum of 5 students to run; classes will have a max of 20 students in the class.

Each elective costs \$50 per month; you can take one or several. The cost to attend the full day is \$150 per month. You will still need to register for each class individually and pay the individual supply fees, so we know the courses you would like to take.

Each class has a supply fee that will be non-refundable and will serve as the registration fee for the class. A spot in the class is not guaranteed until the registration paperwork has been completed and the supply/ registration fee paid. It is not the plan, however, for supply heavy classes such as art we may have to issue a second supply fee, not to exceed the initial supply fee due in January. Registration fees specific to electives are waived for students attending full time Monday- Thursday because you will have the full-time registration fee; this exemption, however, would not apply to a January supply fee.

| Grades | Course Name | Block | Course Description |
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| PK-3 | Primary Grades PE | 1 | A focus on developing fundamental movement skills and introducing basic fitness concepts in a fun and engaging way. <i>\$20 supply fee due at registration</i> |
| 3-12 | Theater | 1 | Building confidence on stage while working on character development, staging, and technical components. Gain improvisation and teamwork skills that can be carried over to life experiences. Full production planned for the spring. <i>\$20 supply fee due at registration</i> |
| 5-8 | Creative Writing | 1 | This engaging course provides a space for middle school students to explore the exciting world of creative writing, developing their voice and refining their storytelling abilities across diverse genres. <i>\$20 supply fee due at registration</i> |

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| 9-12 | Foundations in Personal Finance | 1 | Foundations in Personal Finance aims to equip students with practical money management skills, focusing on budgeting, saving, debt management, and financial planning for the future. It emphasizes building a strong financial foundation through debt-free living, saving for emergencies, and making informed financial decisions. We will be using Dave Ramsey's Homeschool course, curriculum purchase will be required. <i>\$20 supply fee due at registration (this does not include the course text)</i> |
| PK-3 | Intro Theater | 2 | Students will gain confidence performing in front of a group and find their unique voice as we study and act out fairy tales and fables. Teamwork and learning to project will be emphasized as we develop skits and have lots of fun together. <i>\$20 supply fee due at registration</i> |
| 3-8 | Intermediate Grades Art | 2 | This exciting and engaging beginner art class invites students in grades 3-8 to embark on a fun-filled journey of artistic discovery! Throughout the class, young artists will be introduced to fundamental art concepts and techniques, laying a strong foundation for their future artistic endeavors. <i>\$40 supply fee due at registration</i> |
| 6-8 | Middle School: How to read and study the Bible | 2 | The Bible is an amazing book, but we do not read the Bible like we do a novel or textbook. The Bible is not meant to be read merely for information, but for life transformation and application! This year, students will learn how to read and study the Bible in a way that helps them draw real application so they can become lifelong learners of God's Word. Students will also explore some of the major theological doctrines that will help shape their understanding of the Bible and be challenged to make their faith their own. | PK-2 | Animal Explorers | 3 | A fun hands-on class focusing on animal science and exploration. We will look at animal characteristics, habitats, needs, adaptations, life cycles, and conservation efforts using a variety of interactive learning methods. <i>\$20 supply fee due at registration</i> |

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| 3-8 | Intermediate Grades PE | 3 | This comprehensive Physical Education program for students in grades 3-8 focuses on developing foundational movement skills, building fitness, promoting teamwork and sportsmanship, and fostering a lifelong love of physical activity. <i>\$20 supply fee due at registration</i> |
| 6-12 | Upper Grades Art | 3 | This elective course serves as a foundational exploration of the visual arts for students in grades 6-12, regardless of prior experience. It aims to cultivate students' creative abilities, foster artistic expression, and develop an appreciation for art across diverse cultures and historical periods. <i>\$40 supply fee due at registration</i> |
| 9-12 | High School: How to read and study the Bible | 3 | The Bible is an amazing book, but we do not read the Bible like we do a novel or textbook. | 6-12 | Upper Grades PE | 4 | In upper grades physical education, the focus shifts from foundational skill development to applying those skills in more complex movement forms and activities.
