Signal mirror, glass

Whistle, plastic (multi-chambered)

LED headlamp or flashlight with headband

Extra batteries

Medical

Duct tape Pain reliever Safety pins Antihistamine

Tweezers Anti-bacterial ointment Small bottle liquid soap Anti-diarrhea tablets Band-Aids - PolyMem Personal medications

Insect repellent

Pump system for filtration and disinfection (Pre-Mac) or Chlorine Dioxide tablets (MP1) Small folding water bag (1 or 2 liter)

Sturdy knife (full shank, not folding)
