



## Principal Illness Navigation (PIN): patient-first support for high-risk conditions.

When care is complex, it's easy to feel overwhelmed. CCC helps you and your caregiver(s) stay organized, prepared, and supported—so you can focus on your health instead of paperwork, confusion, and missed next steps.

### PIN HELPS WITH

- Coordinating appointments, referrals, and follow-ups
- Visit readiness: questions, notes, and next steps
- Care transitions (hospital → home → rehab)
- Reducing barriers (logistics, access, confusion)
- Caregiver support and consistent check-ins

### Key Principal Illnesses/Conditions for PIN Services

Examples (not exhaustive). Your physician/QHP determines clinical eligibility.

#### Cancer

##### Cancer

Ongoing treatment and navigation across specialists, testing, therapies, and transitions in care.

#### COPD

##### Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD)

Support for chronic respiratory management, acute flare planning, and coordination across care settings.

#### CHF

##### Congestive Heart Failure (CHF)

High-risk cardiovascular care coordination, symptom change planning, and reducing readmission risk.

#### HIV/AIDS

##### HIV/AIDS

Long-term management support, appointment continuity, and wraparound resource coordination.

#### Neurologic

##### Neurologic Disorders

Alzheimer's disease & related dementias, Parkinson's disease, and other progressive neurologic conditions where caregiver support and coordinated care are critical.

#### MS

##### Multiple Sclerosis (MS)

Ongoing navigation for relapsing or progressive disease—therapy coordination, symptom support planning, and continuity.

#### ALS

##### Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS)

High-support navigation for progressive functional decline, caregiver coordination, and care transitions.

#### Other

##### Other Serious Chronic Conditions

Other high-risk conditions may qualify when they meet the CMS criteria below.

#### What PIN provides (patient-forward)

### CMS ELIGIBILITY AND COVERAGE CRITERIA

**Definition:** A serious, high-risk condition that poses a significant risk of hospitalization, nursing home placement, acute exacerbation/decompensation, functional decline, or death.

**Duration:** The condition must be expected to last at least **three months**.
