

Gift of Learning Application Form

The Gift of Learning is a fundraising campaign in which you, the Gifted Learner, are matched with donors (Gifting Heroes) who will contribute towards your learning program through the Canadian Learning Trust. In turn, Gifting Heroes will receive a charitable tax receipt for their support of lifelong learning for Canadians (donations over \$25 Canadian).

How to Apply:

- Contact The Canadian Learning Trust at info@canlearntrust.org
- Make the commitment to the GOL program
- Gather all information required for the application: amount required, length of learning, full and accurate name of learning institution
- Complete the GoldEye Learning Planner & Tracker
- Apply for Individual/Associate (Class B) membership and submit it to the Canadian Learning Trust - if finances are a problem, the membership fee will be waived for the GOL program
- Identify your Learning Heros, email address and submit
- Begin the campaign!

Learning Champion Membership

To apply for programs with the Canadian Learning Trust, you must first become a member of our organization – a Learning Champion! As a program participant, you would be a Class B, non-voting member for the duration of your campaign. Membership fees are \$25 for individuals. You will need to take part in your own fundraising campaign by sharing and promoting it on your **social media**, by **email**, and through word-of-mouth with your own **network**. Information featured in your profile will be curated from your application form and GoldEye in such a way as to protect your personally identifiable information. Applicants who are applying on behalf of a minor will be required to complete a waiver.

Administrative Fees
