Track Competes at BDN

It was an exciting finish that came down to the final race at the Beloit Daily News Invite last Friday that determined the Brodhead Juda men's placement. With 12 teams participating, 11-of-18 events completed, the men were in fifth place. Moving into the final event it came down to the crew of Eric Woodward, Gavin Pinnow, Grant Purdue, and Nathan Engen for the final push. Engen was anchor, on the final curve he surpassed several runners. This relay team took third, 3:42.58, with less than a single second separating them from the next two teams, 3:42:65 and 3:42.78 respectively. The points earned would propel Brodhead to a fourth finish with 74 points. Badger with 167 would take first. Orfordville Parkview, 17.5, would finish tenth. Other notable competitors for Brodhead Juda included first place in the high jump, 6 feet, for Tegan Pinnow. Engen also competed in the long jump and 300m hurdles and took second in each event.

Blake Matthys placed second in shot put and teammates Owen Hillstrom and Ephraim Corbit had personal records. Taking third in 400m was Grant Purdue and Cesar Castro earned third place in the 200m sprint.

The women had a successful night finishing in second place with 101 points. Badger won the event 133.5, and Orfordville Parkview with 32.5 points placed ninth. Kalena Riemer continues to burn up the track taking second place in the 400m, 800m and third in the 1600m. Madi Brown high jumped to second place. She and Brenley Jones had personal bests in the triple jump. Addison Yates was second in the long jump. In field events, Kirsten Fish placed second in discus.

The Rock Valley Conference meet will be held on Saturday at Big Foot.
