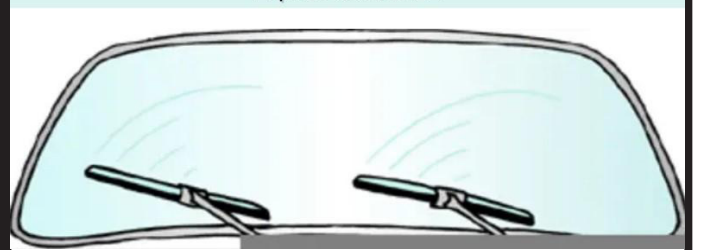

### POOL PARTIES

The Brodhead Pool will be available to rent for private pool parties. The cost for renting the pool is \$50.00 flat fee, plus the cost of paying lifeguards. For pool parties, lifeguards get \$15.00 per guard/per hour. The number of lifeguards needed depends on the size of the pool party. Pool parties may be scheduled during hours when the pool is not being used for open swim or lessons. Pool parties may be scheduled by calling the pool at 608-897-8091 beginning Tuesday, May 31st and because lifeguards must be scheduled to work, please call at least two weeks in advance to schedule a pool party. Also, when you call, please have an idea of how large your party will be so we will know how many guards will be needed.

### T-BALL SIGN UP

Boys and girls ages four, five and six may sign up at the pool beginning Tuesday, May 31st. T-ball is a beginning league that emphasizes learning of fielding, batting and base running skills with games added in starting week three and four. The cost for is \$30 for one session or \$45 for both sessions. The cost includes a T-shirt.

Sessions available: Tuesday and Thursday 6-7 p.m. Bethlehem Lutheran Field. Session 1—June 14th–July 14th (four weeks). \*No T-ball the week of July 4th-8th. Session 2—July 19th-August 11th (four weeks).

Please make sure your child brings his or her glove to every T-ball session to be sure he or she can fully participate. Also, your child

may bring a bat that is appropriate for his or her size if he or she wishes. Please do not bring bats that are too large for your child as it will make it more difficult for him or her to hit the ball.

### TOTS ON THE RUN

Tots on the Run sign-ups can be made at the Brodhead Pool by calling 608-897-8091 starting on Tuesday, May 31st. Tots on the Run will have activities geared for pre-school children aged three-six years. The child must be three by May 31st and can't turn seven during the summer. All children must be potty trained. This class will offer a combination of different activities: crafts, playground and etc. This group will meet for two hours, at Putnam Park, from 9:30-11:30 a.m. Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. The cost is \$40 for one session and \$60 for both sessions. Session 1—June 13th-July 15th (four weeks). \*No Tots on the Run the week of July 4th–8th. Session 2—July 18th-August 12th (four weeks).

### B.L.A.S.T.

The Brodhead Local Area Swimming Team is a competitive youth swimming program for children ages six through 18. The team practices at the Brodhead Pool, and competes in both home and away meets each year. The registration fee for the summer is \$40 per swimmer. For more information, contact a B.L.A.S.T. coach at the pool.

### DISCOUNT ATTRACTION TICKETS

Discounted summer attraction tickets are available through the Brodhead Parks and Recreation Department at Brodhead Pool during open swim hours. Attractions that they have discounts for are the following: Mt. Olympus, Milwaukee County Zoo, Noah's Ark and the Wisconsin Ducks.

### ADULT LAP SWIM/ AQUACIZE

The pool also offers adult lap swim on Monday–Friday mornings from 7-8 a.m. and 5–6 p.m. An opportunity to swim laps continuously. Aquacize is also offered during these times. A combination of exercising and using water dumbbells to help keep you toned.

## Monroe Theatre Guild presents “Right Before I Go,” a play to provide hope for suicide prevention

Monroe Theatre Guild prepares to bring an uplifting message to audiences with their newest production, “Right Before I Go” as part of the Colony Brands performance series. Acclaimed screenwriter and playwright, Stan Zimmerman (The Golden Girls, Roseanne, Gilmore Girls), brings to life the last words written in letters by individuals lost to suicide—including celebrities, veterans, kids that were bullied, LGBTQ, and the clinically depressed—and by those who have survived suicide attempts. This meaningful play is directed for MTG by longtime mental health advocate, Jeff Ditzenberger, and producer Denise Plantenberg.
