GRANTS AVAILABLE

▶ IMPROVEMENT GRANT

Maximum grant = \$35,000





NOTE: A space can receive a max of \$50,000 in Storefront Improvement grants within a 5 year period.

- Level 1 = 50% city match
 Minor projects, such as paint and new signage only
- Level 2 = 70% city match Major projects, such as new windows, awnings, and lighting




DESIGN SERVICES GRANT

(100% city funded)

A city contracted architect is available to help prospective applicants develop a concept or assist create a scope of work that can be sent to contractors to obtain bids.

ELIGIBILITY

Buildings are eligible if they meet the following criteria:

- Primarily commercial use
- Street-front location
- Open to the public
- ▶ Within a Program Area

PROGRAM AREAS

To be eligible for the Storefront Improvement Program, the business and/or property must be located within either the Old Town or Allen Blvd Program Area. See maps to left.
