God provides the covering: Grace

Spiritual Conflict: Genesis 3:15

Genesis 3:15: "And I will cause hostility between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her offspring. He will strike your head, and you will strike his heel."

God is talking to Satan & revealing Satan will be judged and defeated.

1. "And I will cause hostility between you and the woman..."

God is saying there will be constant conflict between Satan and human beings

2. "...and between your offspring and her offspring. He will strike your head, and you will strike his heel."

Here, God promises to bring someone who will defeat Satan.

To rewrite this phrase so it's easier to understand, God is saying to Satan.

There will be hostility between Satan's offspring and some person who is coming from Eve. This person will bruise Satan's head (destroy him) and Satan will bruise this person's heel (hurt him).

This promised person will be the **Redeemer**.
