HOW TO ENROL

What I will need for enrolment?

• ID. National Insurance Number. Contact information. Email/Phone number

<u>Step 1</u> Interested in attending TMP? Get in touch with us and pay us a visit. We can look at the course you are interested in and you can ask us any questions. If you want to talk about the support you need, make an appointment with our <u>Director or Heads of support</u>.

Step 2 Following your visit, if you are still interested in coming to TMP then let your EHCP caseworker or your Local Authority SEND team know. We will need a copy of your EHCP (Education, Health & Care Plan) and a consultation from them.

<u>Step 3</u> Once we have your EHCP and any other information that tells us all about you, if we feel we can meet your needs at TMP we will submit a Funding application to the LA. The LA will then look at the application.

<u>Step 4</u> You're in! Once the LA have decided and confirmed your placement at TMP college, you will receive an offer letter from TMP offering you a place and information about our transition days and enrolment.

ART & DESIGN




Art & Design serves a wide range of professions in the art industry by providing an assortment of courses tailored for freelance artists, tattoo artists, graphic designers, and illustrators.

Whether you're a complete beginner or looking to enhance your current abilities, this course will empower you to cultivate confidence, refine your technique, and unleash your creativity.




You'll Learn a wide variety of skills, including:

At TMP College, students take part in .b (dot-be) — a structured 10-lesson curriculum designed specifically for teenagers. It teaches practical techniques to help us be more in the now; in turn supporting creativity, performance, and skilfully responding to the ups and downs life has to offer.

TMP is not only committed to wellbeing education for our learners, but also for our wider college community. TMP offers MiSP's .b Foundations, an 8-week course for staff, parents and carers to strengthen wellbeing and contribute to a healthier, more compassionate and creatively flourishing community.



CAREERS, INFORMATION, ADVICE & GUIDANCE

We are passionate about supporting our learners to build confident, meaningful futures in the creative industries and beyond. Our Careers, Information, Advice and Guidance (CIAG) service is designed to empower each young person with the knowledge, skills, and support they need to take their next steps, whether that's higher education, employment, or further training.

We provide impartial, personalised advice that helps learners explore a wide range of progression routes. Our Careers Lead is available for one-to-one meetings, offering tailored support with things like CV writing, mock interviews, personal statements, and decision-making around future study or work options.

Work towards their EHCP outcomes, develop independence and life skills, build confidence and routine in the college environment, while preparing for future study on an accredited programme.

RARPA is ideal for learners who need time to settle into college life and make the often significant transition from school or other provisions. With RARPA, they gain the practical and emotional foundations needed to progress onto a UAL-accredited qualification when ready.

SPECIALIST PROVISION & ADULT SOCIAL CARE

We believe creativity should be accessible to everyone. As a specialist creative arts college for young people aged 16–25 with an Education Health and Care Plan (EHCP)

we are proud to offer a nurturing, inclusive, and flexible environment that supports every learner to thrive.

TMP aims to maximise our adult placement offer by supporting young people and adults to develop their skills and abilities to access the life they want to lead.

Every individual and their parents/carers are involved in directing the path of their placement, as is appropriate for adults.





TMP's Adult Placements are designed to take advantage of the continued access to the developmental opportunities available for young adults as they transition from full-time education into adult social care provision.

This will enable them to continue making progress towards the real independent functionality they need to maximise their success and opportunities in life.

- 1-3 days per week (3 days per week initially available, to increase to 4 in-year based on demand)
- Personalised Development Plan to outline annual goals to deliver ongoing progress in independent functionality.
- Access to voluntary work placements in the community
- Involvement in planning and organising our extensive community experience excursions to develop socialisation skills that range from travel training, trips to educational sites and going to restaurants.
- Skills and talent development, including creative skills such as video, podcasting, singing, instrumental, game and character design, and 3D printing.
- Independent living, including shopping, food preparation, housekeeping, hygiene routines, finances, budgeting, cleaning, and travel training.
- Access to life and work skills development through onsite training, including Communication and Emotional Intelligence, Social Skills training, and Employability Skills.

Whether a learner is passionate about visual arts, media, performance, or a mix of creative disciplines, our experienced tutors tailor the curriculum to suit their individual goals, interests, and pace of learning.

We provide a nurturing environment with a high staff-to-learner ratio, ensuring each student receives the attention and support they need to succeed. TMP College's smaller, specialist setting is often preferred by our SEND learners, offering a more comfortable and less overwhelming environment than many larger institutions. Our calm and friendly atmosphere encourages creativity, builds confidence, and supports effective communication.

For those who need an even quieter and more structured learning space, our dedicated Pemberton Campus offers an enhanced support environment, ideal for learners with higher or more complex needs.
