STATEMENT OF FAITH

- e) We believe that the Baptism of believers in the Holy Spirit is evidenced by the initial physical sign of speaking with other tongues as the Spirit gives utterance and by the subsequent manifestation of spiritual power in public testimony and service. (Acts 1:8, 2:4; 10:44-46; 19:2,6).
- f) We believe there is a literal devil who is our adversary; a literal heaven for the redeemed and a literal hell for those who rejected Jesus Christ as their Savior.
- g) We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; that they are saved unto the resurrection of life; or that they are lost unto the resurrection of damnation. (John 5:24, 28-29).
