"RESOLVED FURTHER THAT in pursuant to carry out the Liquidation Proceedings the Board of Directors of the Company do hereby accord the approval the Appointment of Mr. Sanjib Das of M/s Sanjib Das & Associates, Practicing Cost Accountants, House No.4, Green Path, Bora Service, Ulubari, Guwahati-781007, Assam w.e.f 1st of March, 2011 as per the Section 490 of the Companies Act, 1956 who shall be deemed to be the officer of the company to carry out the Liquidation Proceedings and to comply with the relevant provisions of the Companies Act, 1956 with the Registrar of the Company at Shillong at a remuneration of one percent (1%) of the Gross collection of the Fixed, Current & Liquid Assets.
