Heads Up! Hartford COVID-19 Policy 2022

- 1. All campers and staff must be vaccinated against COVID-19.
 - a. Campers must have both doses of an initial vaccination; a booster is preferred
 - b. Staff and volunteers must have completed their initial course and be boosted
- 2. Campers and staff must bring and show CDC vaccination cards.
- 3. All campers and staff must have a negative PCR test within 48 hours of check-in.
- 4. All campers and staff will be expected to adhere to HUH COVID-19 policies (listed here) as well as policies at all our partner sites (Ethel Walker School, worksites, etc.).
- 5. Campers and staff who develop symptoms may be sent home.
- 6. Indoor masking at Ethel Walker will be required if Connecticut case rates are above 15/100,000. Anyone is welcome to mask if they wish.
 - a. Masking is not required when alone in your dorm room.
- 7. Masking outdoors is optional.
- 8. Non-compliance with COVID policies will be handled according to HUH's discipline policy.
- 9. Heads Up! Hartford's camp director, board of directors, operations committee, and staff reserve the right to add or change these policies based on conditions.
