Post Operative Care Instructions

Today was a busy day for me! I had a dental, which may have been a major surgery that has left me tired. The procedure will prevent kidney, liver, and heart disease and help with any bad breath, bleeding gums, pain, and infection I may have had.

If I had any teeth taken out, I might have gotten a pain injection and it's possible that dissolvable sutures were used to help aid with healing. It's normal for me to be drooling and have some blood.

They have told me I have to follow these rules when I get home:

- 1. Check me daily for any excessive bleeding or discharge from my mouth.
- 2. Soreness may last up to 48 hours
- 3. Wait at least one hour after I get home to offer me a small amount of water. They told me that I could eat a small amount of my normal food late tonight and then normal amounts tomorrow.
- 4. My dry food can be moistened with warm water to make eating easier for the next 3 to 5 days.
- 5. Make sure that I eat okay in the days after my surgery. If I don't eat for 2 days in a row, call the hospital.
