
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

Styling/Assembly


- 1) Trace and cut out all petals or set the project up in your machine's design space and cut the petals with a cutting machine as outlined in the table above.
- 2) Create 6 piles of petals (1 Traditional Green, 1 Lime Green, 1 White and 1 Red Pink Petal per pile).
- 3) Take 1 pile of petals and roll each side of the group back/under as shown in the video > cut up the center of the stacked pile of petals 4" (inches) keeping the petals aligned at the base > repeat this process for the remaining 5 piles of petals.
- 4) Starting with one of the piles of petals, glue the petals individually (crossover right corner lines up with center of left tab) as shown in the video > glue the petals starting with the largest to smallest aligned at the base to form one stacked petal > repeat this process for the remaining 5 piles of petals.
- 5) Using a ruler/flexible ruler, measure in **2.75**" (inches) from every straight edge of the hexagon and place a pencil mark.
- 6) Take one of the grouped petals (Petal 1) >flip it towards you>add glue just to the right side>glue the petal edge at one of your pencil marks as shown in the video> turn the flower counterclockwise or to the left.
- 7) Add glue to the next petal (Petal 2) >glue the petal edge at the pencil mark>turn the flower counterclockwise or to the left>continue with Petals 3, 4, and 5.
- 8) Add glue to the Petal 6 > glue the petal edge at the pencil mark and tuck it behind Petal 1.
- 9) Add glue to the bottom left side edge of Petal 1 and press down. Now it is time to create your center!
- 10) To hand cut the center you will need 5 sheets of 8  $\frac{1}{2}$  x 11" pink/red paper.
  - 2 Sheets of the paper cut 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " (inches) off to make the paper size 6 x 11" (inches)> fold in half>along the folded/creased edge fringe cut as close together as possible leaving a  $\frac{3}{4}$ " (inch) gap along the edge as shown below>unfold the two centers as shown>add glue about  $\frac{3}{4}$  (inch) from the top edge of the center all the way across>fold up the bottom piece of the center>glue edge of center at the glue line (You should have approximately 1/2" gap at the top of your center.)>repeat this process for the second center>starting with one of the centers, roll it, keeping the bottom edge aligned>glue periodically as you roll>attach second center>roll it, keeping the bottom edge aligned>glue periodically as you roll>fluff center out.



<u>3</u> Sheets of the paper fold in half>along the folded/creased edge fringe cut as close together as possible leaving a one inch gap along the edge as shown below>>unfold the three centers as shown>add glue about 1" (inch) from the top edge of the center all the way across>fold up the bottom piece of the center>glue edge of center at the glue line >cut off the excess paper, approximately <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" (inch)>repeat for the other 2 centers>with the rounded part of the center facing up, add glue>attach it to the center>roll it, keeping the bottom edge aligned>glue periodically as you roll>attach second center>roll it, keeping the bottom edge aligned>glue periodically as you roll>repeat for last center>untangle any fringe>fluff center out, as needed>flip over and add a generous amount of glue>glue into the center of the flower.

# Styling/Assembly

- 1) Cut the petals, centers and watermelon seeds.
- 2) Starting with the largest petal, glue each petal directly on top (stacked) of each other from largest to smallest with craft glue. *Note*: Be sure to place the petal evenly on top of the previous layers petals.
- 3) Glue 3 black seeds randomly to each pink/red petal as shown in the video. *Note*: I used tweezers to place the seeds.

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- 4) Flip the petal over so the design is facing downwards>place the 3/8" (inch) dowel rod down in the middle of the petal, thumb on top, index finger underneath to hold the dowel rod in place and pinch up and roll the dowel rod with your other hand>go to next petal and repeat until all the petals have been rolled> flip over so the petals are rolled under and the design is facing up>repeat this for all petals.
- 5) Roll the center of each petal with a metal ball stylus on a flower shaping mat to lift the petals or lift/bend the petals up as shown in the video.
- 6) Hot glue layer 2 between the petals of layer 1.
- 7) Stack the 3 centers and pinch each petal of the center around a super skinny dowel or rounded toothpick.
- 8) Separate the centers.
- 9) Thread one of the centers (curl facing up) onto the slotted quilling tool and roll a few times>add glue>keep rolling>add glue periodically as you roll>secure the end.
- 10)Add glue to the second center and glue it onto the center in between the petals of the first center> roll a few times>add glue>keep rolling>add glue periodically as you roll>secure the end.
- 11)Add glue to the third center and glue it onto the center in between the petals of the second center> roll a few times>add glue>keep rolling>add glue periodically as you roll>secure the end.
- 12)Fluff out the center to your liking.
- 13)Glue the center into the center of the flower.
- 14)Glue 3 seeds on top of the center.
- 15)Show off your watermelon inspired flower! Be sure to hashtag your post: #photofabpaperflowerstemplates #photofabpaperflowers #flowercamp #flowercamp2022

ling/Assembl

- 1) Cut the petals and watermelon seeds.
- 2) Glue 3 traditional green individual petals to the red/pink petals > glue 2 traditional green individual petals to red/pink petals as shown in the video.

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- 3) Glue 3 lime green individual petals to red/pink petals > glue 2 lime green individual petals to red/pink petals.
- 4) Glue 3 white individual petals to red/pink petals > glue 2 white individual petals to red/pink petals.
- 5) Glue the black watermelon seeds randomly onto all red/pink petals with craft glue. I generally put 3 seeds on each petal except for the 3.25" red/pink petal, I placed 2 seeds per petal, and for the 3" wide red/pink petal, I placed 1 seed per petal and did this on both sides. Add one additional seed to the very center of one side of the 3" wide red/pink petal.
- 6) Stack the two 4.25" petals with the seeds facing up>place the 3/8" (inch) dowel rod down in the middle of the petal, thumb on top, index finger underneath to hold the dowel rod in place and pinch up and roll the dowel rod with your other hand>go to next petal and repeat until all the petals have been rolled.
- 7) Stack the two 4" petals with the seeds facing up> roll the petals up with a 3/8" (inch) dowel rod.
- 8) Stack the two 3.75" petals with the seeds facing up> roll the petals up with a 5/16" (inch) dowel rod.
- 9) For the remaining three red/pink petals, roll the petals up with a ¼" dowel rod. Roll each size separetly.
- 10)Roll the center of the petals on a flower shaping mat with a metal ball stylus.
- 11)Assemble the petals as shown in the video, alternating placement for each layer. The image below provides an illustration on how to assemble the flower.



- 12)For the 3 red/pink petals we are going to start with the smallest petal (3")>fold up the petals one in front of each other>twist the petals>glue into the 3.25" petal>fold up the petals placing them one in front of the other>twist>glue into the 3.5" petal> fold up the petals placing them one in front of the other>twist>glue into the center of the flower.
- 13)**Optional:** Glue a magnet to the back
- 14)Show off your watermelon inspired flower! Be sure to hashtag your post: #photofabpaperflowerstemplates #photofabpaperflowers #flowercamp #flowercamp2022

## ylin::/Assembly

- 1) Trace and cut out all petals or set the project up in your machine's design space and cut the petals with a cutting machine as outlined in the table above.
- 2) Style the petals as outlined below.
  - ⇒ Petals 6, 5 and 4: Curl each side of the petal back/under at an angle.
  - ⇒ Petals 3, 2 and 1: Curl the left side back/under at an angle and the right side curl up/forward at an angle.
- 3) Cut up the center of the petal as outlined in the table above.
- 4) Glue each petal together (Right outer corner crosses over to meet the left outer corner as shown in the video).

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
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- 5) Using a ruler/flexible ruler, measure in **1**" (inches) from every straight edge of the hexagon base and place a pencil mark.
- 6) **Layer 1 (Petal 6):** Glue a petal at the 1" mark on the base and rotate left or counter clockwise after gluing each petal as shown in the video.
- 7) Using your flexible ruler and pencil, connect the pencil lines to create a hexagon on the base.
- 8) Layer 2 (Second Layer of Petal 6): Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 1 up to the pencil line> rotate left or counter clockwise>continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 2.
- 9) Using your flexible ruler and pencil, measure in ½" from the corner of the hexagon on the base as shown in the video.
- 10)**Layer 3 (Petal 5):** Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 2 up to the pencil dot> rotate left or counter clockwise>continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 3.
- 11)Using your flexible ruler and pencil, connect the pencil lines to create a hexagon on the base.
- 12) Layer 4 (Petal 4): Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 3 up to the pencil line> rotate left or counter clockwise>continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 4.
- 13)Layer 5 (Petal 3): Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 4 at the corner of the hexagon (do not come in any further on the base for this layer)> rotate left or counter clockwise>continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 5.
- 14)Using your flexible ruler and pencil, measure in  $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the straight edge of the hexagon in the center on the base as shown in the video.
- 15)Layer 6 (Petal 2): Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 5 up to the pencil dot> rotate right or clockwise>continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 6. *Note*: Tuck the last petal's edge behind the first petal.
- 16)Freehand the connection of the dots on the base with a pencil. The hexagon will be approximately 1".
- 17) Layer 7 (Petal 1): Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 6 up to the edge of the hexagon (do not come in any further on the base for this layer)> rotate right or clockwise>continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 7. Note: Tuck the last petal's edge behind the first petal. Congratulations you completed the petal portion of your flower!
- 18)Let's create the center!

To hand cut the center:

cut a piece of paper 3 x 11"> fold the paper in half>along the folded/creased edge fringe cut as close together as possible leaving a ½" (inch) gap along the edge as shown below>unfold the center as shown>add glue along the top edge of the center all the way across>fold up the bottom piece of the center>glue the edges evenly together>roll the center, keeping the bottom edge aligned>glue periodically as you roll>fluff center out to your liking>add a generous amount of hot glue>glue into the center of your flower.

## Styling/Assembly

- 1) Trace and cut out all petals **or** set the project up in your machine's design space and cut the petals with a cutting machine as outlined in the table above.
- 2) Style all petals: With the point of the petal pointing to the left, curl the top right of the petal back/under as shown in the video.
- 3) Cut up the center (center of the base of the petal) of the petal as outlined in the table above.
- Glue each petal together (Cross over to create a triangle as shown in the video).
- 5) Using a ruler/flexible ruler, measure in **2**" (inches) from every straight edge of the octagon base and place a pencil mark.
- 6) Layer 1 (Petal 5): Glue a petal at the 2" mark on the base and rotate \_\_\_\_\_\_ left or counter clockwise after gluing each petal as shown in the video.




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- 7) Using your flexible ruler and pencil, connect the pencil lines to create a octagon on the base.
- 8) Layer 2 (Second Layer of Petal 5): Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 1 up to the pencil line> rotate left or counter clockwise>continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 2.
- 9) Layer 3 (Petal 4): Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 2 at the corner of the octagon (do not come in any further on the base for this layer)> rotate left or counter clockwise>continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 3.
- 10)Draw a ¼" center circle/dot in the center of the octagon base.
- 12)Layer 5 (Petal 2): Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 4 up to the dot (do not cover the circle/dot)> rotate left or counter clockwise>continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 5.
- 13)Layer 6 (Petal 1): Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 5 up to the dot (do not cover the circle/dot)> rotate left or counter clockwise>continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 6. *Note*: Tuck the last petal's edge behind the first petal.
- 14) Layer 7 (Petal 1): Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 6 up to the dot (do not cover the circle/dot)> rotate left or counter clockwise>continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 7.
   Note: Tuck the last petal's edge behind the first petal.
- 15)You can go back in and recurl layer 7 petals as noted in the video.*Congratulations you completed the petal portion of your flower!*
- 16)Let's create the center!

To hand cut the center:


cut a piece of paper 3 x 11"> fold the paper in half>along the folded/creased edge fringe cut as close together as possible leaving a ½" (inch) gap along the edge as shown below>unfold the center as shown>add glue about ½" from the edge>fold up the bottom piece of the center and glue about ¼" from the top edge >roll the center, keeping the bottom edge aligned>glue periodically as you roll>fluff center out to your liking>add a generous amount of hot glue>glue into the center of your flower.

- 1) Trace and cut out all petals *or* set the project up in your machine's design space and cut the petals with a cutting machine as outlined in the table above.
- 2) Style the petals as outlined below. The dowel rod diameter sizes used for each petal size are noted in the table above.
  - Petals 10, 9 and 8: With the point of the petal pointing to the left, place the dowel rod down in the middle of the petal and roll dowel rod in the center to create a curve (do not crease it)>roll each side of the petal back/under as shown in the video.
  - ⇒ Petals 7 and 6: With the point of the petal pointing to the left, curl the top right of the petal back/under as shown in the video.

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
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- 3) Cut up the center (center of the base of the petal) of the petal as outlined in the table above.
- 4) Glue each petal together (Right outer corner crosses over to meet the left outer corner as shown in the video). *Note*: For Petal 6, Camp Counselor Vee crossed over a little bit more to form a triangular point.
- 5) Using a ruler/flexible ruler, measure in **2.5**" (inches) from every straight edge of the octagon base and place a pencil mark.
- 6) **Layer 1 (Petal 10):** Glue a petal at the 2" mark on the base and rotate left or counter clockwise after gluing each petal as shown in the video.
- 7) Using your flexible ruler and pencil, connect the pencil lines to create a octagon on the base.
- 8) Layer 2 (Second Layer of Petal 10): Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 1 up to the pencil line> rotate left or counter clockwise>continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 2.
- 9) Draw a ¼" center circle/dot in the center of the octagon base.
- 10)**Layer 3 (Petal 9):** Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 3 up to the dot (do not cover the circle/dot)>rotate left or counter clockwise>continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 3.
- 11)**Layer 4 (Petal 8):** Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 3 up to the dot (do not cover the circle/dot)>rotate <u>right or clockwise</u>>continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 4.
- 12)Layer 5 (Petal 7): Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 4 up to the dot (do not cover the circle/dot)> rotate left or counter clockwise>continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 5. Note: For the 1<sup>st</sup> petal of Layer 5, only place glue on the right side of the petal. Tuck the last petal of layer 5 under the 1<sup>st</sup> petal and secure petal 1 with glue.
- 13) Layer 6 (Petal 6): Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 5 up to the dot (do not cover the circle/dot)> rotate <u>right</u> or <u>clockwise</u> >continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 6. Note: Tuck the last petal of layer 6 under the 1<sup>st</sup> petal and secure petal 1 with glue.
- 14) Congratulations you completed the petal portion of your flower! Let's create the center! To hand cut the center:

Fold the paper in half>fold in half again>along the folded/creased edge fringe cut as close together as possible leaving a  $\frac{1}{2}$ " (inch) gap along the edge as shown below>unfold the center and cut down the center to create 2 centers>add glue about  $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the edge>fold up the bottom piece of the center and glue about  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the top edge >repeat for the second center>roll the center, keeping the bottom edge aligned>glue periodically as you roll>attach the second center>glue periodically as you roll>fluff center out to your liking>add a generous amount of hot glue>glue into the center of your flower.

## Sfyling/Assembly

- 1) Trace and cut out all petals **or** set the project up in your machine's design space and cut the petals with a cutting machine as outlined in the table above.
- 2) Style the petals with the detail of the petal on the right, curl the top right of the petal back/under at an angle as shown in the video. The dowel rod diameter sizes used for each petal size are noted in the table above.
- 3) Cut up the center of the petal as outlined in the table above.
- 4) Glue each petal together (Right outer corner crosses over to meet the left outer corner as shown in the video).



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- 5) Using a ruler/flexible ruler, measure in **2**" (inches) from every straight edge of the octagon base and place a pencil mark.
- 6) Layer 1 (Petal 6): Glue a petal at the 2" mark on the base and rotate <u>right</u> or <u>clockwise</u> after gluing each petal as shown in the video. *Note*: For the 1<sup>st</sup> petal of Layer 1, only place glue on the left side of the petal. Tuck the last petal of layer 1 under the 1<sup>st</sup> petal and secure petal 1 with glue.
- 7) Using your flexible ruler and pencil, connect the pencil lines to create a octagon on the base.
- 8) Layer 2 (Petal 5): Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 1 up to the pencil line> rotate right or clockwise >continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 2. Note: Tuck the last petal of layer 2 under the 1<sup>st</sup> petal.
- 9) Layer 3 (Petal 4): Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 2 (do not come in any further on the base; this layer should line up with layer 1)> rotate <u>right</u> or <u>clockwise</u> >continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 3. *Note*: Tuck the last petal of layer 3 under the 1<sup>st</sup> petal.
- 10)Layer 4 (Petal 3): Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 3 (do not come in any further on the base; this layer should line up with layer 2)> rotate <u>right</u> or <u>clockwise</u> >continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 4. *Note*: Tuck the last petal of layer 4 under the 1<sup>st</sup> petal.
- 11)Layer 5 (Petal 2): Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 4 (do not come in any further on the base; this layer should line up with layers 1 and 3)> rotate <u>right</u> or <u>clockwise</u> >continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 5. *Note*: Tuck the last petal of layer 5 under the 1<sup>st</sup> petal.
- 12)Layer 6 (Petal 1): Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 5 (do not come in any further on the base; this layer should line up with layers 2 and 4)> rotate <u>right</u> or <u>clockwise</u> >continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 6. *Note*: Tuck the last petal of layer 6 under the 1<sup>st</sup> petal.
- 13)Congratulations you completed the petal portion of your flower! Let's create the center! To hand cut the center:

Fold the paper in half>fold in half again>unfold the paper and cut down the center>freehand a pointy shape as shown in the video from the open end>cut the center out from the open end>repeat this process for the second center>use a dowel rod or bone folder to curl the centers>with the fringe/eyelash curl facing up, roll the center, keeping the bottom edge aligned>glue periodically as you roll>press the center down from the top to shape it>attach the second center>glue periodically as you roll>fluff center out to your liking>add a generous amount of hot glue>glue into the center of your flower.

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
