- ⇒ Ruler/Flexible Ruler

- ⇒ 7 1/2" (inches) **Octagon Base** – Cut in White
- ⇒ If using the spider image from Cricut Design Space (#M3F5CC725), cut spiders at **4", 3" and 2" (Inches) Heights** in black

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STYLING/ASSEMBLY

- 1) Trace and cut out all petals **or** set the project up in your machine's design space and cut the petals and spiders with a cutting machine as outlined in the table above.
- 2) Stack the petals by size.
- 3) Place a piece of scrap paper down on your work surface.
- 4) Use the blending tool to tint the edges of all petals as outlined below and shown in the [video](#).
 - Add Twilight in a circular motion around the edges of the top half of the petal and down the center slightly



- Add Black Jack in a circular motion around the edges of the top half of the petal and down the center slightly




- 5) **Styling:** Use the 3/8" dowel rod and roll each side of the petal under/back as shown in the [video](#).
- 6) Cut up the center of the petals as outlined in the table on the previous page.
- 7) Glue each petal together (right side of petal crosses over the left) as shown in the video and below. **Notes:** Petals 10 and 9 are glued 2/3 of the way and Petal 8 is glued about 3/4 of the way. Petals 7 and 6 are glued corner to corner.

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STYLING/ASSEMBLY, *continued*

- 8) Using a ruler/flexible ruler, measure in **3" (inches)** from every straight edge of the octagon and place a pencil mark.



- 9) **Layer 1 (Petal 10):** Add glue to $\frac{1}{2}$ of the first petal (bottom right) and glue petal at the 3" mark on the base (do not cover up the pencil mark) and rotate left or counter clockwise after gluing each petal as shown in the [video](#). The rest of the petals of layer 1 you can add glue across the bottom of the entire petal. **Note:** Tuck the last petal behind the first petal and add a little glue to the bottom left of the first petal.
- 10) **Layer 2 (Petal 9):** Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 1 up to the pencil line> rotate left or counter clockwise>continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 2.
- 11) **Layer 3 (Petal 8):** Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 2 up to the pencil dot> rotate left or counter clockwise>continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 3. **Note:** Tuck the last petal's edge behind the first petal.
- 12) **Layer 4 (Petal 7):** Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 3 up to the pencil line> rotate left or counter clockwise>continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 4. **Note:** Tuck the last petal's edge behind the first petal.
- 13) Use a pencil and freehand a $\frac{1}{2}$ " circle in the center as shown below and in the video.



- 14) **Layer 5 (Petal 6):** Add glue to $\frac{1}{2}$ of the first petal (bottom right)>glue in between the petals of layer 4 up to the center circle and apply pressure>rotate left or counter clockwise>continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 5. **Note:** Tuck the last petal behind the first petal and add a little glue to the bottom left of the first petal. *Congratulations you completed the petal portion of your flower!*



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STYLING/ASSEMBLY, *continued*

- 15) **Style the Spiders:** Use a metal ball stylus tool on a foam mat/flower shaping mat and roll the body to create dimension>pinch the body in half to separate the top half from the bottom half as shown in the video>use the metal ball stylus and roll the legs>crease the legs at the body and pinch the legs about half the way down the leg as shown in the video.
- 16) Glue one of the 4" spiders (not styled – flat) to the center of the flower to cover up the pencil circle.



- 17) Start creating your center using the spiders and attaching them with glue. Use your discretion in creating the center and have some fun with this!



- 18) **Optional:** Add some spider webbing to the flower and secure with glue.



- 19) Add additional spiders to your petals in different directions and layers (as if they are crawling around).

STYLING/ASSEMBLY


- 1) Cut the petals and circle as outlined in the table above.
- 2) Fan fold the two 4" W petals as shown in the video>when looking at the top of the petal>turn petal to the right>fold forward>fold backward>fold up from the bottom>fold backward>unfold the petals. **Note:** Do not flatten the petals as you want them to have creases/ruffles.



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STYLING/ASSEMBLY, *continued*

3) **Optional:** Ink the edges of 4" petals you fan folded. I used [Festive Berries](#) Distress Oxide.



4) Cut the 4" petals in 1/2 as shown in the video.





5) Glue the petals you cut in half together, alternating placement in between the previous layer's petals>set aside.



6) Stack the petals by color from largest to smallest.

7) Glue white petals to red or other colored petals on **both** sides as follows.

- 3 White Petals to a 3.75" W Petal
- 2 White Petals to a 3.75" W Petal
- 3 White Petals to a 3.5" W Petal
- 2 White Petals to a 3.25" W Petal
- 3 White Petals to a 3" W Petal
- 2 White Petals to a 2.75" W Petal
- 3 White Petals to a 2.5" W Petal



7) Roll all the petals up with the dowel rod size noted in the table.

8) **Optional:** Ink the edges on **both** side of just the **white** petals.




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
STYLING/ASSEMBLY, *continued*

9) Assemble the clown as outlined below and in the video.


Layer 1: Do not roll center.




Layer 2: Roll center with MBS and glue in between the petals of layer 1.




Layer 3: Roll center with MBS and glue in between the white petals in between the petals of layer 2.




Layer 4: Roll center with MBS and glue in between the white petals in between the petals of layer 3.




Layer 5: Roll center with MBS and glue in between the white petals in between the petals of layer 4.




Layer 6: Roll center with MBS and glue in between the white petals in between the petals of layer 5.




Layer 7: Roll center with MBS and glue in between the white petals in between the petals of layer 6.




Layer 8: Roll center with MBS and glue in between the white petals in between the petals of layer 7.



Layer 9: Add glue to the back of the ruffled/fan folded paper and glue to the bottom of the flower as the collar of the clown>glue a 1.5" circle on the back.



10) Thread the rectangle in the slotted quilling tool>roll the rectangle>secure the end with glue>add glue to one end and glue into the center of the flower.



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STYLING/ASSEMBLY, *continued*

11) Draw a face of a clown on the 1.25" circle with a pencil and black marker. Below are some options. 😊



12) **Optional:** Use a red marker and color in the mouth/nose.



13) Flip the circle over the face is facing downward>roll the circle with a larger metal ball stylus on a flower shaping mat to give the face dimension>add glue to the top of rolled rectangle>attach the face to the center.



14) If using a wood bead for the nose>color the nose with a red marker>glue to face with the openings facing downward towards the ruffles and upwards towards the hair.



15) **Optional:** Add some red ink around the circular face.



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STYLING/ASSEMBLY, continued

16) Cut off 3 pieces from the leaf for hair sprouts > roll the 3 pieces with an embossing stylus on a flower shaping mat > add glue > attach to the underside of the circle face as shown in the video.



17) **Optional:** Drizzle some red dimensional paint on the clown.

- ⇒ Approximately 3 1/2" H, Hanging Foam Skull – Vee purchased her skull at Michaels

- ⇒ Black spider webbing or color of your choice

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STYLING/ASSEMBLY

- 1) Trace and cut out all petals **or** set the project up in your machine's design space and cut the petals.
- 2) Stack the petals by size.
- 3) **Styling:**
 - **Petal 6** - Use the 3/8" dowel rod and roll each side of the petal under/back as shown in the [video](#) and bend the tips up.
 - **Petals 5 and 4** – Use the 5/16" dowel rod and roll each side of the petal under/back as shown in the [video](#) and bend the tips up.
 - **Petal 3** – Use the 5/16" dowel rod and roll each side of the petal up as shown in the [video](#) and bend the tips up.
 - **Petals 2 and 1** – Curl/roll the top down using the 3/8" dowel rod.



- 4) Cut up the center of the petals as outlined in the table on the previous page.
- 5) Glue each petal together (outer right side of petal crosses over and glued to the outer left corner) as shown in the [video](#).



- 6) Using a ruler/flexible ruler, measure in **1" (inches)** from every straight edge of the octagon base and place a pencil mark.
- 7) **Layer 1 (Petal 6):** Glue a petal at the 1" mark on the base and rotate left or counter clockwise after gluing each petal as shown in the [video](#).

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STYLING/ASSEMBLY, continued

8) Using your flexible ruler and pencil, connect the pencil lines to create an octagon on the base.




9) **Layer 2 (Petal 5):** Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 1 up to the pencil line > rotate left or counter clockwise > continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 2.

10) **Layer 3 (Petal 4):** Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 2 at the corner of the octagon (do not come in any further on the base for this layer) > rotate left or counter clockwise > continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 3.



11) Using your flexible ruler and pencil, measure in $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the straight edge of the octagon in the center on the base as shown in the video.


12) **Layer 4 (Petal 3):** Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 3 up to the pencil line > rotate left or counter clockwise > continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 4.

STYLING/ASSEMBLY, *continued*

- 13) Connect the pencil lines to create an octagon on the base.
- 14) **Layer 5 (Petal 2):** Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 4 on the straight edge of the octagon (do not come in any further on the base for this layer) > rotate left or counter clockwise > continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 5. **Note:** Tuck the last petal's edge behind the first petal.



- 15) **Layer 6 (Petal 1):** Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 5 at the corner of the octagon (do not come in any further on the base for this layer) > rotate left or counter clockwise > continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 6. **Note:** Tuck the last petal's edge behind the first petal. *Congratulations you completed the petal portion of your flower!*




Let's create the center!

- 16) Peel off the wrapper of the crayons and place a piece of scrap paper on your workspace.
- 17) Using a lighter melt some of the **Black** crayon in the eyes (5 drips) > lean the skeleton head forward to allow the wax to drip out of the eyes.



- 18) Using a lighter melt some **Violet Red** or a crayon color of your choice in the eyes (5 drips) > lean the skeleton head forward to allow the wax to drip out of the eyes.

STYLING/ASSEMBLY, *continued*

19) Add a generous amount of hot glue to the back of the skull and glue it into the center of the flower. Be sure to hold it there until it dries.



20) Now it's time to add drips to your petals. Use the colors of your choice and melt the wax on the petals and let the wax drip down the petals. Have some fun with this!



21) **Optional:** Add black spider webbing to the flower or a color of your choice.

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

STYLING/ASSEMBLY

- 1) Cut the petals, centers, bats or spiders and circle as outlined in the table above and on the previous page.
- 2) **Style Center 3** - Roll up the bowling pin looking petal with a 1/8" dowel rod and the smaller petals with 18-gauge floral wire>set the centers to the side.
- 3) **Optional:** Add black ink with a finger dabber around the edge of all 5 petals and 3 Center 2 Centers as shown in the video. I also added some ink to the tips of the back of each petal.
- 4) Roll the petals up with the dowel rod sizes noted on the previous page (video: 31:05 time).
Note: Do not roll the petals of Center 2 at this time.
- 5) Cut in between each petal of Center 2 as shown below and in the video (Time: 35:08).




- 6) Cut a piece of spider web tulle at approximately 12" >fold the tulle to be about 1 1/2" wide to fit one individual petal (size of one petal cut off of the 4.5" W petal) as we are going to cut around the petal.
- 7) Place the individual petal on top of the tulle >use your scissors and cut around it (it will not be perfect and that's ok)>cut 21 tulle petals



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STYLING/ASSEMBLY, *continued*


- 8) **Layer 1 (4.5" W Petal):** **Do not roll the center of the petal!** Add dots of hot glue where the petals meet the base and attach a tulle petal to each, as shown in the video (Time: 43:40) and below.




- 9) **Layer 2:** Cut a 4.5" circle from the plain black tulle>add a small amount of glue in the center of layer 1>gather the tulle>press into the center of the flower.




- 10) **Layer 3 (4.5" W Petal):** Roll the second 4.5" W petal with a metal ball stylus on a flower shaping mat where the petals meet the base> Add dots of hot glue where the petals meet the base and attach a tulle petal as shown in the video and below>add glue to the back of the petal>glue in between the petals of the previous layer.



- 11) **Layer 4:** Cut a 4.5" circle from the plain black tulle>add a small amount of glue in the center of layer 1>gather the tulle>press into the center of the flower.



- 12) **Layer 5 (4.25" W Petal):** Roll the 4.25" W petal with a metal ball stylus on a flower shaping mat where the petals meet the base> Add dots of hot glue where the petals meet the base and attach a tulle petal as shown in the video and below>add glue in between the petals of the previous layer.




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STYLING/ASSEMBLY, *continued*

13) **Layer 6:** Cut a 3.75" circle from the plain black tulle>add a small amount of glue in the center of layer 1>gather the tulle>press into the center of the flower.



14) **Layer 7 (4" W Petal):** Roll the second 4" W petal with a metal ball stylus on a flower shaping mat where the petals meet the base>add glue to the back of the petal>glue in between the petals of the previous layer>roll the metal ball stylus in the center of the flower to make sure the petal adheres to the previous layer.



15) **Layer 8:** Cut a 3.75" circle from the spider web tulle>add hot glue in the center of the flower>gather the tulle>press into the center of the flower.



16) **Layer 9 (3.75" W Petal):** Roll the second 3.75" W petal with a metal ball stylus on a flower shaping mat where the petals meet the base>add glue to the back of the petal>glue in between the petals of the previous layer>roll the metal ball stylus in the center of the flower to make sure the petal adheres to the previous layer.



17) **Layer 10:** Cut a 3.75" circle from the spider web tulle>add hot glue in the center of the flower>gather the tulle>press into the center of the flower.



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STYLING/ASSEMBLY, *continued*

18) Thread the center into the slotted quilling tool (with the roll facing up) > roll a few times > add glue > continue rolling > secure end with glue > add glue to the next center > attach to center > roll > secure end > add the third center using the same process.




19) **Optional:** Add some black ink/distress oxide to the center as shown in the video.

20) Roll the petals up of Center 2 with the dowel rod sizes noted in the table.



21) Place the centers on the flower shaping mat in order of smallest to largest > roll the centers with the metal ball stylus on the flower shaping mat.



22) Glue the rolled center into the smallest center > fold up the petals > glue into the next center > fold up the petals > glue into the largest center 2 center > fold up the petals > glue into the center of the flower.



23) **Optional:** Add some additional ink to the petals/center.

24) **Optional:** Add 3 spiders/bats or a combination to the flower. For the spiders, roll the body with a metal ball stylus to shape the spider/add dimension and bend the legs.

STYLING/ASSEMBLY

- 1) Cut the petals, centers, spiders, rectangle strips and circle as outlined in the table above and on the previous page.
- 2) Glue 3 wiggle/googly eyes to the 5 petals of template 1 mini flower with craft glue.



- 3) Ink all 15 rectangle strips with black ink with a finger dabber on one side.




- 4) Stack the petals by size>using the craft glue wrap the eye petals with the rectangle strips as shown in the video (Time: 15:50) and below. **Be careful as the petals are delicate!**



- 5) Roll the petals of Template 2 Mini Flower – Center 4 up with a 1/8" dowel rod and the smaller petals with 18-gauge floral wire>distress the centers with black ink.




- 6) Roll the black center/sepals up with the dowel rod sizes noted in the table.






- 7) Flip the petals over the wiggle/googly eyes are facing downward>roll the petal up with the dowel rod size noted in the chart>flip back over so the eyes are facing up>do this to all the mummy/zombie petals.



- 8) Carefully ink the edges of all petals with black ink before you start assembling the flower.
Optional: Add some red ink as well. *Oops, I accidentally forgot to do this until later in the video.*
- 9) **Layer 1:** Place the circle on the flower shaping mat>roll the center of one of the 4" W petals with a metal ball stylus on a flower shaping mat>add glue to back of petal>attach to the center of the circle.




- 10) **Layer 2:** Roll the center of the second 4" W petal with a metal ball stylus on a flower shaping mat>add glue to back of petal>glue petals in between the petals of layer 1.



- 11) **Layer 3:** Roll the center of the 3.75" W petal with a metal ball stylus on a flower shaping mat>add glue to back of petal>glue petals in between the petals of layer 2.



- 12) **Layer 4:** Roll the center of the 3.5" W petal with a metal ball stylus on a flower shaping mat>add glue to back of petal>glue petals in between the petals of layer 3.






- 13) **Layer 5:** Roll the center of the second 3.5" W petal with a metal ball stylus on a flower shaping mat>add glue to back of petal>glue petals in between the petals of layer 4.



- 14) Thread the center into the slotted quilling tool (with the roll facing up)>roll a few times>add glue>continue rolling>secure end with glue>add glue to the next center>attach to center>roll>secure end>remove from slotted quilling tool>add some additional black and red ink to the top and sides.



- 15) Add glue to the bottom of the center>glue into the center of the flower.



- 16) Roll the centers of the sepals (petals should be rolled under) with a metal ball stylus on a flower shaping mat and attach from largest to smallest to the back of the flower in between the previous layers' petals>flip the flower over.



- 17) **Optional:** Add some white spider webbing to the flower and spiders. For the spiders, roll the body with a metal ball stylus to shape the spider/add dimension and bend the legs.

- ⇒ **4 1/2"** (inches) **Hexagon Base** – Cut in Red
- ⇒ If using the fly and beetle images from Cricut Design Space (Fly - #M267AC532 and Beetle - #M7B80534), cut them at **1 1/2"** and **2"** (Inches) **Heights** in black

STYLING/ASSEMBLY

- 1) Trace and cut out all petals **or** set the project up in your machine's design space and cut the petals, flies and beetles with a cutting machine as outlined in the table above.
- 2) Stack the petals by size.
- 3) Place a piece of scrap paper down on your work surface.
- 4) Use the blending tool to tint the edges of all petals as outlined below and shown in the [video](#).

Add both colors in a circular motion around the edges of the petal on both sides.



- 5) Use the black marker and add a cracked petal design as shown in the video and below. Each petal will be different. Add this design to one side of 2-3 petals per layer.

STYLING/ASSEMBLY, *continued*

6) Soften the lines by using the ink and blender tool as shown in the video.



7) **Styling Petals 5, 4, and 1:** Use the dowel rod size noted in the table on the previous page and roll each side of the petal under/back as shown.




8) **Styling Petals 3 and 2:** Roll each side of the petal up/forward with the dowel rod size noted in the table on the previous page.



9) Cut up the center of the petals as outlined in the table on the previous page.

10) Glue each petal together right side of petal crosses over the left as shown in the video and below. **Note:** Glue each petal corner to corner.



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STYLING/ASSEMBLY, *continued*

- 11) Using a ruler/flexible ruler, measure in **1.5" (inches)** from every straight edge of the hexagon and place a pencil mark.
- 12) **Layer 1 (Petal 5)**: Glue petal at the 1 1/2" mark on the base (do not cover up the pencil mark) and rotate left or counter clockwise after gluing each petal as shown in the video.



- 13) **Layer 2 (Petal 5)**: Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 1 up to the pencil line> rotate left or counter clockwise>continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 2.



- 14) **Layer 3 (Petal 4)**: Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 2 up to the corners of the hexagon (the petals will be lined up with layer 1 in between the petals of layer 2)> rotate left or counter clockwise>continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 3.



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STYLING/ASSEMBLY, *continued*

- 15) **Layer 4 (Petal 3):** Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 3 up to the straight edges of the hexagon (the petals will be lined up with layer 2 in between the petals of layer 3)> rotate left or counter clockwise>continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 4.



- 16) **Layer 5 (Petal 2):** Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 4 up to the corners of the hexagon (the petals will be lined up with layers 1 and 3 in between the petals of layer 4)> rotate left or counter clockwise>continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 5.



- 17) **Layer 6 (Petal 1):** Glue a petal in between the petals of layer 5 up to the straight edges of the hexagon (the petals will be lined up with layers 2 and 4 in between the petals of layer 5)> rotate left or counter clockwise>continue adding the rest of the petals for layer 6.



Congratulations you completed the petal portion of your flower!


18) Add some black ink to 2 skulls>glue two skulls into the center of a ball of black Hay-Foin or black spider webbing shown in the video and below.



19) Add some white spider webbing over the top of the skulls and use a generous amount of glue to attach the skulls and webbing into the center of the flower.



20) **Style the paper flies and beetles.** Use the metal ball stylus tool on a foam mat/flower shaping mat and roll the body to create dimension>bend the legs>attach to the center and petals at your discretions with craft glue.



21) Add flies and beetles to your petals in different directions and layers (as if they are crawling around).

22) Show off your flower! Be sure to hashtag your post: #foreverpetalsbyvee #foreverpetalsbyvee #halloweenspooktacular # halloweenspooktacular2022 #paperflower halloweenspooktacular
