

T-REC PARK




T-REC PARK is the culmination of a partnership between four Treynor women that would not give up a variety of dreams for a way to make their community better. Efforts began in June of 2017 to chase their dreams and make them come true by forming and funding the Treynor Splash Pad Committee.. Wendy Andersen, Brooke Curtis, and Rachel Horton wanted a Community Splash Pad for their kids to play on.

Wendy also wants to build an Inclusive and Accessible playground in tribute to her kids, especially her son Dexter, who was diagnosed with Tuberosus Sclerosis, Epilepsy and later Autism. Dexter's Dream Foundation was born, and Dexter's Dream Playground will be a reality.

And then the women were joined by a real champion, Lisa White, mother of Tristan White, a teenager from Treynor, that lost his life in November of 2015 running with his Wrestling teammates on a gravel road on the edge of town. In order to truly celebrate Tristan's life and to prevent another tragedy from happening, Lisa has focused on creating off street trails for running, walking, and biking to help keep all residents safe. The T-REC will be a 1-acre fun park that will bring everyone from Treynor and the surrounding communities together to splash, play, stretch, train, run, and celebrate a wonderful Iowa Community and a wonderful young man.



Tristan White was just 14 years old, and just 6 days away from his 15th birthday, when he was tragically taken from his family, friends, and community while he was running with other young athletes on a country road. Nobody should ever have this happen, and it is with that singular purpose that Lisa White, Tristan's mother is working tirelessly to create Tristan's Trail and many other ways to keep young athletes and residents of all ages safe by providing an off-street place to gather, stretch, and run safely. Early on, Lisa was joined by the organization **Keep Kids Alive Drive 25** with funding and support. The first thing you see when you get to the T-REC PARK is Tristan's Trail and an amazing outdoor fitness gathering place for all athletes to gather, celebrate Tristan's life, and run on concrete or natural cross country trails. Everyone can rest and relax under the Shelter and observe the Tristan White Memorial.

TREYNOR SPLASH PAD

In June of 2017, a group of Community Volunteers in Treynor, Iowa believed strongly that Treynor needed a Community Splash Pad. These Volunteers began raising money, working with the City, developing plans, and through an amazing amount of conviction and persistence, the Treynor Splash Pad will be a reality within the T-REC Park as a centerpiece of the new community recreation park. The Recirculating NIRBO Splash Pad will use minimal water by recirculating, cleaning, and chlorinating water stored in an underground tank to provide cool refreshing water to the above ground and below ground sprays that provide for an Accessible and Inclusive water play experience for users. ***Come get wet in Treynor.***

There is a support building for the Splash Pad that includes two restrooms and a mechanical room for the high tech computer operated system of pumps and filters.



NOTE: The Splash Pad is enclosed by a 4' safety fence per Iowa Safety Rules




