

DevCon Madrid: Everything you need to know

You can watch livestreamed events from the 15th biannual conference for software builders that is taking place from April 25-27.



The <u>Amazon Software Builder Experience (ASBX)</u> organization and the <u>Engineering Excellence (EE)</u> Events team will host the first of two 2023 DevCon events live in Madrid from April 25–27. While registration is currently wait-listed, you can still participate virtually. If you're not familiar with the conference, there are lots of resources to get you up to speed and ready for the next one in Boston. Read on for more.

I've never heard of DevCon. What is it?

DevCon (short for Developer Conference) is an event geared toward software builders at Amazon. DevCon's mission is to educate and empower software builders, helping them to further innovate for customers while advancing their knowledge and career growth. The conference features interactive workshops, networking sessions, and career development presentations.

How can I attend?

Although in-person registration is closed and the event is wait-listed, you can still attend virtually—no registration required—by viewing the livestreams of select sessions on Broadcast. Head to the agenda and click on a session, and you'll see a link if that session is being livestreamed. Livestream highlights for DevCon Madrid include the keynote session on Tuesday, April 25, by the Amazon Software Builder Experience (ASBX) leadership team, a panel on navigating career growth, and presentations from principal engineers on new innovations. Inside Amazon News will be spotlighting select livestreaming sessions leading up to DevCon, so be sure to check back here for more information.

Additionally, all sessions will be available on Broadcast in the days following the event.
