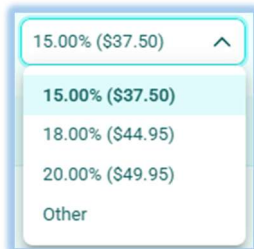
After entering your donation amount, Zeffy proceeds to ask these questions.

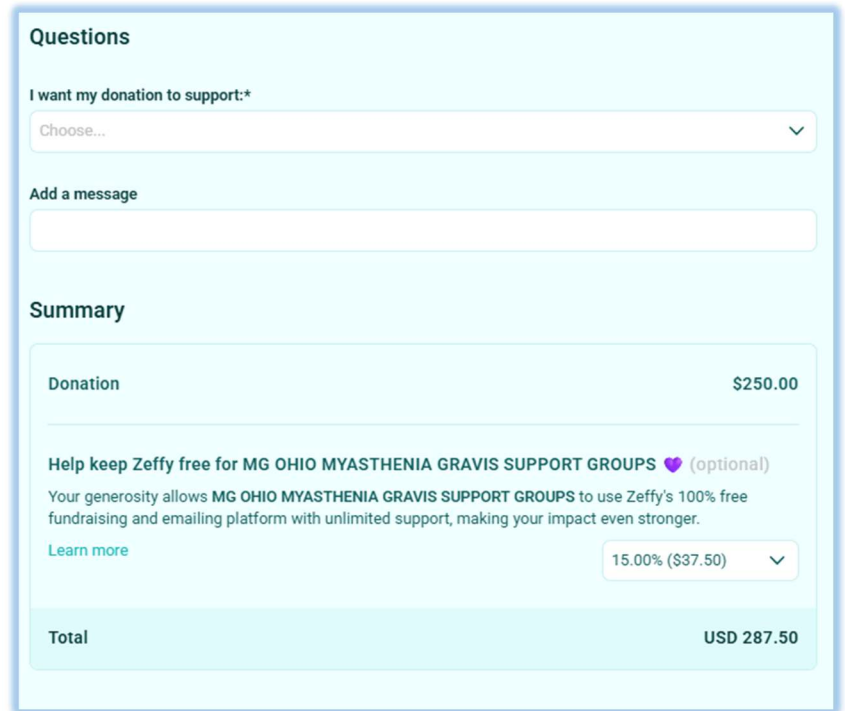

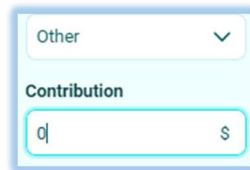
