### Ask the Expert

What changes are coming to insurance plans in 2026?

Insurance plan premiums, including Medicare Part B (original plan) and Part D (medications), are expected to rise in 2026. The amount of the cost increase in insurance plans will vary from company to company, and even from state to state. But, everyone in the industry agrees that costs will be significantly higher, more than 10%. At present no one is certain about the extent of the rising costs. This is also true with government costs and/or subsidies because Congress has yet to vote on some of the proposed changes.

What can you do to ensure that your plan is the best for you? Many of our Support Groups held a special session last month with a speaker to explain the expected changes and offer advice to those who need help in finding the best plan. If your Support Group has any literature from these talks, please talk to the leader in your area and ask for it. We have attached to this newsletter, information about some changes in Medicare, and Medicaid specific to the state of Ohio.

An excellent option would be to consult with a health insurance broker. Brokers are very different than insurance agents. Brokers' services are paid for by insurance companies and are free of charge to you. Brokers are fiduciaries – which means they are obligated to work in the best interest of their client - you. *They find the best* product (insurance plan) for the client rather than the best client for the company. As with all products, MG

# **€** Key Medicare and Medicaid Changes Coming in 2026

### **MyCare Ohio changes**

- Only 4 carriers will offer FIDE Effective January 1st, 2026 (Fully Integrated Dual Eligible) plans: Anthem, Buckeye, CareSource, and Molina.
- April 1, 2026 Program begins in remaining counties
- By August 2026 Program should be available statewide
- This means fewer choices and possible plan disruption for those currently enrolled
- Age eligibility shifts from 18+ to 21+. This means younger adults may lose coverage

# VBID program ends, SSBCI replaces it

- Income-based extra benefits disappear. (Healthy Food Cards, Utility Cards, Transportation Assistance, ETC.)
- New SSBCI program is stricter and only for certain chronically ill. This could mean fewer may qualify

# Original Medicare adds prior authorization

- Some outpatient procedures (e.g., skin/tissue substitutes, neurostimulators, incontinence devices) now require approval.
- Could cause delays or denials for necessary care

## Prescription drug costs shift

- Part D annual cap rises from \$2,000 to \$2,100.
- \$35 insulin cap & free vaccines remain.
- Slightly higher costs for some enrollees.
