Ask the MG Expert

Q. How does Mestinon (pyridostigmine bromide work)?

A. Mestinon is one of a class of drugs that acts as an antiacetylcholinesterase:

- When your brain sends a signal for your muscle to move, acetylcholine is released from the nerve side of the neuromuscular junction(NMJ).
- The acetylcholine binds with the acetylcholine receptor on the muscle side of the NMJ to trigger your muscle to move.
- Acetylcholinesterase is then released which breaks down the acetylcholine (ACH) so that frees up the receptors to receive another message.
- Mestinon prevents the rapid breakdown of ACH by acetylcholinesterase which usually results in muscle strengthening.
- Mestinon usually takes 20—30 minutes to act. If you need it more rapidly, you can place the Mestinon under your tongue where it will dissolve and get into your bloodstream faster.
- Mestinon is short lived. It has a half-life of approximately 4 hours. That is why it is helpful to take Mestinon throughout the day.
- Mestinon is hygroscopic. A fancy way of saying that it absorbs water from the atmosphere readily.
- Store Mestinon in a watertight container.
