

Currently they are paying \$100 per hour. So if you answer a 15 minute survey, you've just made \$25 or if you participate in an hour long group chat, you get \$100. Nice passive income. #### Has COVID-19 Left You Financially Strapped?

The National Organization for Rare Disorders (NORD) has opened a financial assistance program for people in the rare disease community including those with MG, who are affected by the COVID-19 pandemic in the U.S. Called the NORD COVID-19 Critical Relief Program, the effort will provide up to \$1000.00 annually to those eligible to support critical non-medical needs.
