ORDINANCE No. 1.

SUN CITY, KANSAS

AN ORDINANCE DESCRIBING THE PLACE OF MEETING AND THE TIME OF MEETING AND THE TIME OF MEETING OF THE GOVERNING BODY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SUN CITY? KANSAS.

SECTION 1. That the governing body of the City of Sun City shall meet in the back room of the Sun State Bank building. And in this room shall be held the regular meetings and all other meeting of the council body.

SECTION 2. That the regular meetings of the governing body of the City of Sun City, Kansas, shall be held on the first Monday evening of each month, unless, the first Monday evening of the month falls on the same evening the employees of the Best Bros., Keene's Cement Co., receive their pay, usually known as "Pay Day," then, the regular meeting of the governing body shall be held on the Tuesday evening following the first Monday evening of the month.

SECTION 3. That the time of beginning of all regular meetings shall be at eight (8) o'clock P.M.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after the 15th day of March, 1930.
