ORDINANCE No. 12.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF TRAFFIC IN THE  
CITY OF SUN CITY, BARBER COUNTY, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SUN CITY:

Section 1. That all vehicles being operated and proceeding along First Ave. West Street, Washington Street and First Ave. East Street, shall be brought to a complete stop immediately in front of and before proceeding upon the intersection of Main Street and any of said streets; and that all such vehicles are prohibited from making what is known as a "U" turn at the intersection of Main Street and Washington Ave. Street, and at the intersection of Main Street and First Ave. West Street, in said City.

Section 2. That no automobile or other vehicle shall be permitted to run or be operated upon the streets of said City without a proper and sufficient exhaust muffler, and with the cut-out being closed.

Section 3. That any person, firm or corporation, violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$1.00, nor more than \$25.00, for each offense.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and posted in 10-ten public places in the City of Sun City.

Section 5. Passed by the Mayor and Council, the governing body of said City, this 4th day of April, 1932.
