

## ORDINANCE No. 13.

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS,  
FIREWORKS, AND OTHER DANGEROUSLY COMBUSTIBLE MATERIAL  
IN THE CITY OF SUN CITY, BARBER COUNTY, KANSAS.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SUN CITY:

Section 1. That from and after the effective date of this ordinance, every person who shall willfully, unlawfully and maliciously discharge any fireworks, rockets, powder or other dangerously combustible material, and any person who shall discharge any firearms, other than a duly elected and qualified peace officer of said City, said County, said State, or The United States of America, in the streets, lots, grounds, alleys, or about or in the vicinity of any buildings, within the said City of Sun City, Barber County, Kansas, except on the fourth day of July of each year, commonly known as Independence Day, shall on conviction thereof, be fined in a sum not less than \$1.00, nor more than \$25.00, or by imprisonment in the county jail for a period not exceeding 30 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment, for each such offense.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and posted in 10-ten public places in the City of Sun City.

Section 3. Passed by the Mayor and Council, the governing body of said City, this 4th day of April, 1932.
