ORDINANCE No. 14.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF THE ERECTION OF  
BUILDINGS ON MAIN STREET, IN THE CITY OF

SUN CITY, BARBER COUNTY, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SUN CITY:

Section 1. That from and after the effective date of this Ordinance, no building shall be erected on Main Street between the intersection of First Ave. East Street and First Ave. West Street except those buildings whose walls fronting Main Street are built of brick, tile, concrete or any fire proof material, and whose side walls and rear walls are built either of brick, tile or concrete, and no brick building shall be erected without having 16 inch walls.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and posted in 10-ten public places in the City of Sun City.

Section 3. Passed by the Mayor and Council, the governing body of said City, of Sun City, this 4th day of April, 1932.
