ORDINANCE No. 15.

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY WITHIN THE

CITY OF SUN CITY, BARBER COUNTY, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SUN CITY:

Section 1. That from and after the effective date of this Ordinance, every person who shall wilfully, unlawfully and maliciously break, destroy or injure the door or window of any dwelling house, shop, store or other house or building, or any part of such house, or building, or sever therefrom or from any gate, fence or inclosure, or any part thereof, any material of which it is formed, or sever from the ground, remove, move or overturn any such house or building, or sever from the freehold, any produce thereof, or any gate, post, railing or fence, or any other personal property, or any part thereof, or cut down, lop, girdle or otherwise injure or destroy any fruit or ornamental shade tree, being the property of another, or take or drive away from the premises of the owner thereof, any livestock, machinery, automobile or other vehicle, without the consent of the owner thereof, or take, remove or damage any horse or other animal or any automobile, wagon or other vehicle lawfully parked upon the streets of said City, shall on conviction, be fined in a sum not less than \$1.00, nor more than \$25.00, or by imprisonment in the county jail for a period not exceeding 30 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and posted in 10-ten public places in the City of Sun City.

Section 3. Passed by the Mayor and Council, the governing body of said City, of Sun City, this 4th day of April, 1932.
