ORDINANCE No. 19.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION AND LICENSEING OF
DANCE HALLS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES OF AMUSEMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SUN CITY

BARBER COUNTY, KANSAS:

Section 1. That no person, persons, firm or corporation shall be allowed to run or operate, for profit, a dance hall or other public dances or public amusements of any kind within the City limits of said City, without having first secured a license from the City Clerk of said City, for which shall be paid the sum of two (\$2.00) dollars per day or night for the term of said license.

Section 2. That any person or persons, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this act shall be subject to a fine of not less than five (\$5.00) dollars, nor more than twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars, upon conviction thereof, for each such day or night said place is so operated.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication by posting true copies thereof in ten (10) public places in said City of Sun City.

Section 4. Passed by the Mayor and Council, the governing body of said City of Sun City, Kansas, this 6th day of March, 1933.
