ORDINANCE No. 20.

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE OBSTRUCTION OF THE SIDE WALKS AND THE GROUND ALONG THE SIDE OF BUILDINGS USED AS A SIDE WALK; AND ALSO, TO PREVENT THE OBSTRUCTION OF THE STREETS, ALLEYS, DITCHES AND GUTTERS BY LEAVING LITTER OR ANY OTHER KIND OF OBSTRUCTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SUN CITY:

Section 1. That no person, persons, corporation or firm shall be allowed to park a car or cars, truck or trucks or any other kind of vehicle on the side walks or within eight (8) feet of any building fronting on any street where a side walk should be, nor on any street crossing where a side walk should be made.

Section 2. That no person or persons shall be allowed to obstruct any side walk, street, alley, ditch or gutter, within the city limits, by leaving or placing any litter or other obstruction in any of them, whatsoever.

Section 3. That any person or persons, violating either of the above sections (Sections 1 and 2) of this Ordinance, it shall be termed a misdemeanor, and shall be liable to arrest and trial, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than One (1) dollar and costs nor more than Five (5) dollars and costs, or twenty (20) days in jail or both as the judge may decide.

Section 4. That it shall be the duty of the marshal to arrest or cause to be arrested, and brought before the Police Judge, any person or persons found violating any part of this Ordinance.

Section 5. That this Ordinance shall be in effect and full force from and after its publication by posting in ten (10) public places in the City of Sun City, Kansas.

Section 6. Passed and approved by the Governing Body of the City of Sun City State of Kansas, this 8th day of January, 1934.
