ORDINANCE No. 21.

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE LICENSING OF CERTAIN BEVERAGES,
MORE COMMONLY KNOWN AS BEER TAX.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SUN CITY, KANSAS:

Section 1. That any person, coming into the city limits, and selling malt cereal beverage or beverages by the case or keg or barrel, shall be termed a wholesaler, and shall pay a license tax of twenty (\$20.00) dollars per year, or ten (10.00) dollars for (6) months.

Section 2. That all persons engaged in the sale, at retail, of malt cereal beverage or beverages shall pay a license tax of ten (\$10.00) dollars per year or Five (\$5.00) dollars for six (6) months for the privilege of retailing to patrons patronizing their place or places of business.

Section 3. That all retailers of malt cereal beverage or beverages shall close their beer sale promptly at twelve (12) o'clock each night, and shall not resume the selling until six-30 o'clock of each morning thereafter.

Section 4. That any person or persons, corporation, or company violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than one (1) dollar and costs nor more than twenty (\$20.00) dollars and costs, or confined in jail not less than thirty (30) days nor more than sixty (60) days or both, according to the decision of the Judge.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval and posted in ten (10) public places in the City of Sun City.

Section 6. Passed and approved by the Mayor and Council, the Governing Body of the said City of Sun City, Kansas.
