ORDINANCE No. 22.

AN ORDINANCE TO GOVERN THE CONDUCT AND BEHAVIOR IN ANY PLACE OR PLACES IN SUN CITY WHERE MALT CEREAL BEVERAGES ARE SOLD, WHETHER PROPRIETOR, CUSTOMER OR OTHERS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SUN CITY, KANSAS:

Section 1. That any person or persons, selling malt cereal beverages or beer, shall not permit any misconduct, as fighting, swearing, blackguarding, indecent language, drunkenness or any other kind of vulgarity in or about his or their place or places of business, and he or they shall not engage in such indecencies themselves.

Section 2. That any person, violating the above section, it shall be termed a misdemeaner, he shall be arrested and tried, and if found guilty, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than one (\$1.00) dollar and costs nor more than twenty (\$20.00) dollars and costs or not less than ten (10) days nor more than thirty (30) days in jail or both according as the court may decide.

Section 3. That when any place of business shall be declared a public nuisance by the Mayor and Council, the license to sell or dispense malt cereal beverage or beverages shall be revoked and the place closed.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and posted in ten (10) public places in the City of Sun City.

Passed and approved by the Mayor and Council, the Governing Body, of the said City of Sun City, Kansas.
