

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULAR CITY ELECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SUN CITY:

Section 1. That the regular city election of the City of Sun City, Kansas, shall be held on Monday, the fifth day of April, 1937, from the hours of 8 o'clock A. M. to 6 o'clock P. M. in the City Hall, ^{in the city} ~~in the City Hall,~~ for the purpose of electing a mayor, a police judge and five councilmen.

Section 2. That J. T. Lawson, P. W. Bissantz and E. G. Harris, are hereby designated by the mayor, with the approval of the council, to act as judges of said election: and Harry Sears and Armer Reese are here-

by designated by the council to act as clerks of said election.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official paper of the county.
