

SUN CITY, KANSAS.

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING TO THE ORDINANCE NO. 19 RELATING TO DANCES IN THE CITY OF SUN CITY, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SUN CITY, KANSAS.

Section 1. That, Ordinance No. 19, relating to Dance licenses and other amusements, mentioned in said Ordinance No. 19, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. That, Herein after, no person, persons, company, or corporation shall be allowed to hold or run or conduct a dance or any other form of amusement, for profit, inside the limits of the corporation of the City of Sun City, Kansas. And that no license shall be issued.

Section 3. That, any person, persons, company, or corporation violating this Ordinance, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be arrested and tried and if found guilty, shall be fined not less than Ten (10) Dollars and costs, nor more than Twenty-five (25) Dollars and costs, or Thirty (30) days in jail, or both as the Judge may decide.

Section 4. That, This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval, and publication, by posting Ten (10) true copies thereof, in ten (10) public places in the City of Sun City, Kansas.

Section 5. Passed by the Mayor and Council, The Governing Body of the City of Sun City, Kansas, This the 30th day of December, 1937.
