

Ordinance No.36

An ordinance providing for the regular City Election.....

Be it ordained by the governing body of the

City of Sun City.

Section 1. That the regular city election of the City of Sun City Kansas, shall be held on the fifth day of April 1943 from the hours of 8 O'clock AM to 6 O'clock PM in the Hotel Building for the purpose of electing a mayor, a police judge and five councilmen.

Section 2. That E. Bullock, Homer F. Pearce, Mrs. A. P. Smelser are hereby designated by the Mayor, with the approval of the Council, to act as judges of said election; and Mrs. Robert Rose and Miss Helen Ward are hereby designated by the Council, to act as clerks of said election.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after this date.
