

For all power consumers having connected loads of 5 H P or over:

First 50 K W H used per H P per month	8¢
Next 60 " " " " " "	6¢
Next 60 " " " " " "	5¢

All excess K W H used per H P per " 4¢  
Minimum bill \$1.00 per H P for the first 10 H P.  
75¢ for each H P above 10 H P.

All bills concerning above rates as to each sub-division are net and when payment therefor is not made on or before the tenth day after rendition of bill a penalty of ten per cent will be added.

per cent per annum will be paid on the amount of the principal during the period of one year or longer.

SECTION 5. It is understood that if the expense of furnishing such electric current or service mentioned above shall so increase or diminish that the prices set out above shall not be reasonable to said Company, or to the City or the consumers of electric current, then that such prices shall be subject to change upon application of the City, the Company or of the consumers, to the Public Service Commission of the State of Kansas, or other body having jurisdiction thereof, and the lawful orders of such body shall be binding upon both the City and the Company.

SECTION 6. The Rezeau Brothers Power Company shall at all times during the period for which this franchise is granted, make all line extensions warranted by the business that is available, furnish all meters and construct and maintain all service appliances to the consumer's house from its pole line supporting the secondary service, providing that when it is impossible to connect the consumer to the secondary line with one span of wire and it is necessary to set a pole or poles on the consumer's property in order to support the service wire, then the consumer shall pay all expense incurred in installing the pole or poles and additional span or spans of service wire.

SECTION 7. In consideration of the grant, right and privilege contained herein, The Rezeau Brothers Power Company agrees that it will during the term of this franchise, maintain and operate said electric system and furnish current thereover continuously, except for interruptions caused by floods, fire and other causes beyond the control of such Company affecting such service.

SECTION 8. Within thirty days from the date of the passage of this ordinance The Rezeau Brothers Power Company shall file with the City Clerk of said City of Sun City its written acceptance of the terms and provisions of this ordinance, and from the filing thereof, this ordinance and such acceptance shall be deemed to be a contract between such City and said Company.

SECTION 9. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.

FRANCHISE ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO THE REZEAU BROTHERS POWER COMPANY, A CORPORATION, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, THE RIGHT TO CONSTRUCT, OPERATE AND MAINTAIN, POLES, WIRES, TRANSMISSION LINES, DISTRIBUTION SYSTEMS AND OTHER APPLIANCES IN, THROUGH, OVER AND ACROSS THE STREETS, ALLEYS AND PUBLIC GROUNDS OF THE CITY OF SUN CITY, KANSAS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRANSMITTING, DISTRIBUTING AND SELLING ELECTRIC CURRENT TO SAID CITY AND THE INHABITANTS FOR DOMESTIC AND INDUSTRIAL USES, FOR LIGHTING THE STREETS OF SAID CITY AND OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SUN CITY, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That for and during the period of twenty (20) years from the date of this agreement, there is hereby granted to The Rezeau Brothers Power Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate and maintain poles, wires, transmission lines, distribution systems and other appliances, in, through, under, over and across streets, alleys, and public grounds of the City of Sun City, Kansas, for the purpose of transmitting, distributing and supplying electric current to the City of Sun City, Kansas, and its inhabitants for domestic and industrial uses, lighting the streets of said city and all other purposes, and for all or any of said purposes to erect, operate and maintain all necessary poles, wires, transmission lines, conduits, distribution systems, machinery, generating plants and other equipment and appliances which may be necessary for such purposes.

SECTION 2. All poles, wires and other appliances erected and maintained hereunder shall be so erected and maintained as to obstruct or impede the use of the streets or alleys of said city as little as possible.

SECTION 3. The Rezeau Brothers Power Company, its successors and assigns, shall at all times defend, indemnify and save harmless the City of Sun City, Kansas, from and against all lawful claims for injury to person or property caused by the operations of the company under this franchise.

SECTION 4. The Rezeau Brothers Power Company, its successors and assigns shall have the right to make the following charges for electric current furnished for domestic and industrial uses under this franchise.

RESIDENCE AND COMMERCIAL RATE

For all residence and commercial consumers with a connected load of less than 5 K W:

First 25 K W H per month 12 1/2¢ per K W H  
Next 25 " " " 10¢ "

For all current used in excess of 50 K W H per month 8¢ per K W H  
Minimum bill \$1.00 per month.
