

ORDINANCE NO. 44.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULAR CITY ELECTIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SUN CITY, KANSAS,

SECTION 1. That the regular City election of the City of Sun City, Kansas, shall be held on Tuesday, April 3, 1957, from the hours of 8:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. in the Community Room of the Rural High School, Sun City, Kansas, for the purpose of electing a Mayor, a Police Judge, and five (5) Councilmen.

SECTION 2. That Ruth McLain, Mildred Hogard, and Daphna Baessler are hereby designated ~~xxx~~ by the Mayor, with the approval of the Council to act as judges of election. That Hattie Mae Pearce and Maxine Pearson are hereby designated by the council to act as clerks of said election.

SECTION 3. That any person desiring their name to be placed on the official ballot for any office as designated in Section 1 must register their name with the City Clerk on or before March 24, 1957.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its legal postings within the City of Sun City, Kansas.
