

ORDINANCE NO. 46

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 33.

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE OF CEREAL MALT BEVERAGES, PROVIDING FOR LICENSING OF PERSONS SELLING THE SAME, PRESCRIBING LICENSE FEES, PRESCRIBING RULES AND REGULATIONS, PROVIDING FOR THE REVOCATION OF LICENSES, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SUN CITY, KANSAS:

Section 2 of Ordinance No. 33 reads as follows:

There is hereby prescribed license fees as follows: To retail cereal malt beverages on tap, in the bottle, can or other container \$30.00 per calendar year.

The full amount of the license fee shall be required regardless of the time of year in which the application is made and the licensee shall only be authorized to operate under the license for the remainder of the calendar year in which the license is issued.

Section 2 of Ordinance No. 33 set forth above shall be repealed and amended to read as follows:

There is hereby prescribed license fees as follows: To retail cereal malt beverages on tap, in the bottle, can or other container \$200.00 per calendar year.

The full amount of the license fee shall be required regardless of the time of year in which the application is made and the licensee shall only be authorized to operate under the license for the remainder of the calendar year in which the license is issued.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULAR CITY ELECTION:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SUN CITY, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the regular city election of the City of Sun City, Kansas, shall be held on Tuesday, April 4, 1961, from the hours of 8:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. in the Community Room of the Rural High School, Sun City, Kansas, for the purpose of electing a Mayor, a Police Judge and five (5) Councilmen.


SECTION 2. That Ruth McLain, Myrtle Adams, and LeVerne Danley are hereby designated by the Mayor with the approval of the Council to act as Judges of election; That Hattie Mae Pearce and Maxine Pearson are hereby designated by the Council to act as clerks of said election.

SECTION 3. That any person desiring their name to be placed on the official ballot for any office as designated in Section 1, must register their name with the City Clerk on or before March 25, 1961.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after it's legal publication and legal postings within the City of Sun City, Kansas
