

ORDINANCE NO. 48.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULAR CITY ELECTION:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SUN CITY, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the regular City election of the City of Sun City, Kansas, shall be held on ~~Tuesday~~, April 2, 1963, from the hours of 8:00 A.M. to 6@00 P. M. at the Sun City Rural School, in the City of Sun City, Kansas, for the purpose of electing a Mayor, A Police Judge, and five (5) Councilmen.

SECTION 2. That Myrtle Adams, Ruth McLain, and Maxine Peatson are hereby designated by the Mayor with the approval of the Council to act as Judges of said election. That LaVern Danley and Marian Shepler are hereby designated by the Council to act as clerks of said election.

SECTION 3. That any person desiring their name to be placed on the official ballot for any office as designated in Section 1, must register their name with the City Clerk on or before March 22, 1963.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its legal postings within the City of Sun City, Kansas.
