

ORDINANCE NO. 49

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULAR CITY ELECTION:  
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY  
OF SUN CITY, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the regular city election of the City of Sun City, Kansas, shall be held on Tuesday, April 6, 1965, from the hours of 8:00 A M to 6:00 P M in a designated class room of Sun City Rural School, as indicated by sign at west entrance of said School, in the City of Sun City, Kansas, for the purpose of electing a Mayor, a Police Judge and five (5) Councilmen.

SECTION 2. That Maxine Pearson, Dessie Manning, and Myrtle Adams are hereby designated by the Mayor with the approval of the Council to act as judges of said election; That Mariam Shepler and Laverne Danley are hereby designated by the council to act as clerks of said election.

SECTION 3. That any person desiring their name to be placed on the official ballot for any office as designated in section 1 must register their name with the City Clerk on or before March 26, 1965.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its legal postings within the City of Sun City, Kansas
