ORDINANCE NO. 50

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULAR CITY ELECTION:  
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY  
OF SUN CITY, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the regular city election of the City of Sun City, Kansas, shall be held on Tuesday, April 4, 1967, from the hours of 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM in a designated room of the Sun City Grade School building, as indicated by sign at west entrance of said building, in the City of Sun City, Kansas, for the purpose of electing a Mayor, a Police Judge and five (5) Council members.

SECTION 2. That Laverne Danley, ~~\_\_\_\_\_~~ *Betty deCaire* and Janice Martin are hereby designated by the Mayor with the approval of the Council to act as judges of said election. That Hattie Mae Fearce and ~~Otelia Garte~~ *Otelia Garte* are hereby designated by the council to act as clerks of said election.

SECTION 3. That any qualified person desiring their name to be placed on the official ballot for any office as designated in section 1 must register their name with the City Clerk on or before March 24, 1967.
