

ORDINANCE NO. 65

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE TERMS OF OFFICE OF ELECTED OFFICERS, THE TRANSITION OF THOSE TERMS TO THE NOVEMBER ELECTION CYCLE, AND NOMINATION PETITION REQUIREMENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SUN CITY, KANSAS:

Section 1. (a) The governing body consists of a mayor and five council members. The mayor and council members shall be residents and qualified electors of the City of Sun City, Kansas. Every two years an election shall be held for a mayor, and five council members. The mayor and council members shall hold their offices for two years and until their successors are elected and qualified.

(b) Those positions that would have expired in April 2017, shall expire on the second Monday in January of 2018, when the city officials elected in the November 2017 general election take office. The position of Mayor which would have expired in April 2017, shall expire on the second Monday in January of 2018, when the Mayor elected in the November 2017 general election takes office.

Section 2. All elections for the City of Sun City, Kansas shall be nonpartisan.

Section 3. In accordance with K.S.A. 25-205, and amendments thereto, any person may become a candidate for city office elected at large by having had filed on their behalf, a nomination petition or a declaration of candidacy, accompanied by any fee required by law. The nomination petition must be signed by two of the qualified electors of the City of Sun City.

Section 4. The ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately following its adoption and publication as provided by law.
